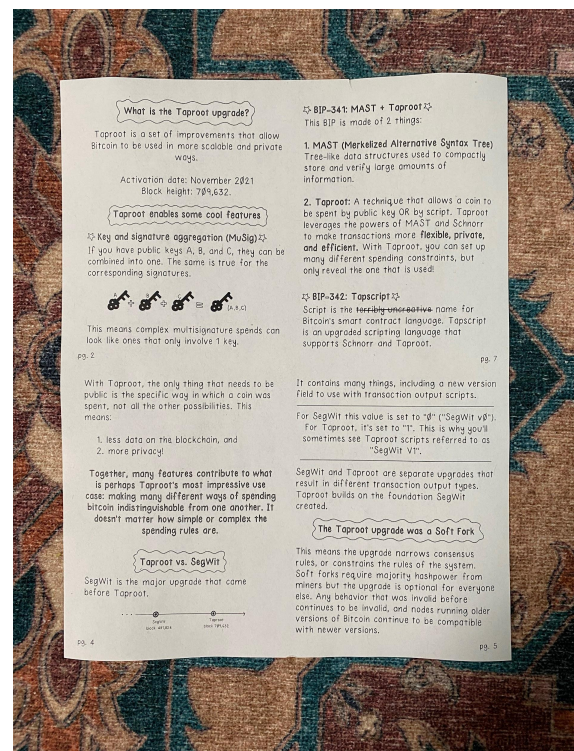
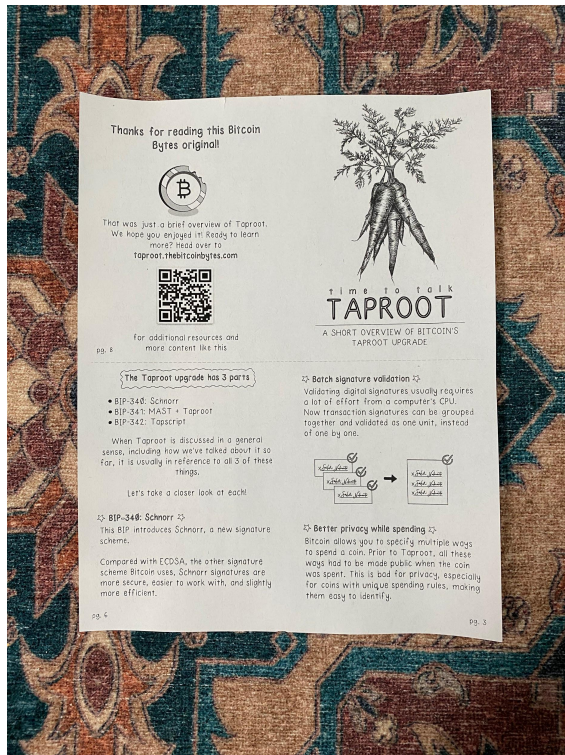


Let's make some zines!

Step 1. Make a double sided print of the zine.

The front page will look like this first photo, and the back page will look like the second.



These are the settings I use for my printer. Note the “Two-Sided” box is checked, and the “Scale to Fit” option is selected. This ensures page numbers don’t get cut off.

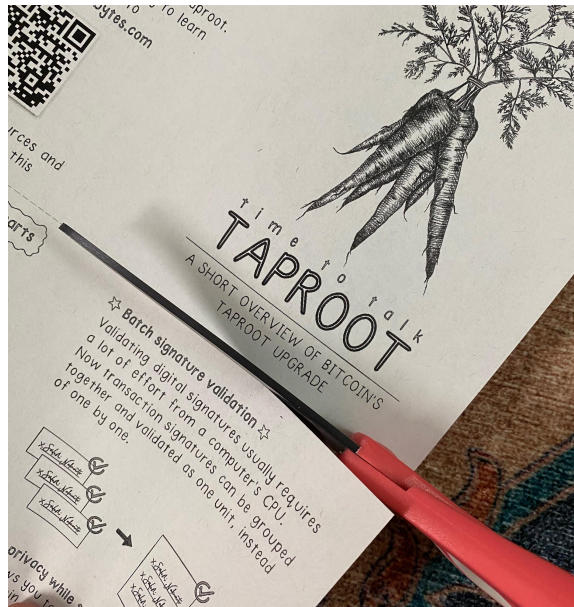

Step 2. Cut along the dotted line



Step 3. Place the top half of the page on top of the bottom half



Step 4. Fold the stack in half.

Double check that the page numbers are correct. You can bind your zine with a stapler or sewing machine and it's ready to go!
