## **TEACHING APTITUDE ASSESSMENT**

## **CLASSROOM DEMONSTRATION/PRESENTATION**

The following requirements have been advertised in reference of the recent advertisement of various faculty positions in the various departments of the University:-

- i. Before the personal interview, the university shall assess the teaching aptitude and ability of the candidate through a Lecture/demonstration.
- ii. The shortlisted candidates shall be required to make a demonstration/presentation before the duly constituted committee, prior to appearing for interview before the Selection Committee. Grading shall be given by the above committee to all the candidates as 'A', 'B', 'C' & 'D' on the basis of their performance/presentation.
- iii. The confidential report, placed in a sealed coved duly signed by all the members of the committee, shall be provided to the Chairman of the concerned Selection Committee for necessary consideration during the interview of the candidates. Decision of his/her suitability shall be taken by the duly constituted concerned Selection Committee.
  - For implementation of the above, the candidates are required to demonstrate an around half an hour class room teaching. The topic for the same shall be relevant to the departmental core subjects and preferably from respective program.

The candidates are expected to showcase their teaching potential which should exhibit not only that a candidate is prepared for the major task of teaching, but also that he or she is well prepared for establishing his or her own research projects. This is based on the very fact that just as research enhances teaching; it is also true that teaching enhances research. During the demonstration, the candidate shall be judged for the following major points

- Organization of the class.
- Accuracy of the contents.
- Quality of presentation.
- Connection of the audience.
- Demonstration of knowledge.
- Level of confidence and enthusiasm.
- The language, writing and presentation.
- Engaging the class.
- Response to questions.
- Teaching philosophy/strategy.
- iv. The candidate may design his/her own lecture plan considering as mention above.
- v. The audience shall be the duly constituted Committee members, Faculty members, Research scholars and students.
- vi. The class rooms shall be equipped with the whiteboard, writing pen and other required supporting material.
- vii. In line with the already issued schedule, candidates are required to report as per detail given in Call letter.
