PSLF: Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program. Trump wants “to deny PSLF eligibility for those working under organizations that the administration claims harm American values.”

Student Loans: Trump’s House has proposed eliminating subsidized and Direct Plus loans and requiring borrowers to make payments for 30 years before potential loan forgiveness. [House Republicans want to hold colleges accountable when students default on their loans while Senate Republicans want to deny loans to programs that fail an earnings test](#).

CCAMPIS: Trump budget eliminates childcare subsidy for parents going to college.

SEOG: Trump budget eliminates funding for Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants.

FIPSE: Trump budget proposed [cutting \\$195 million](#) for FIPSE Grants.

CTE State Grants: Trump’s budget proposes \$2.2 M cut to Career and Technical Education State Grants.

ESL Funding: Trump budget eliminates Title III funding for ESL programs.

Adult Education: Trump budget would eliminate all funding for Adult Education.

Rural Education Program: “Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP) would be thrown into one pot with formula grants such as Rural Education and McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance, leaving it up to states to decide how (or whether) to support these students.”

PDG B-5: Preschool Development Grant Birth through Five program. Trump budget would eliminate this program.

SCSEP: Senior Community Service Employment Program. [Trump proposes cutting the program](#).

Title I Programs: Under the Trump budget, the following programs would see funding cut by \$700 M: Comprehensive Literacy Development Grants, Innovative Approaches to Literacy, Education for Migrant Students, Support for Neglected and Delinquent Students.

Countries

Canada: ([1st entry](#)) Trump [refuses to rule out military annexation](#) of Canada as 51st state. [Trump threatens financial penalties if Canada doesn't become the 51st state](#).

Greenland: Trump threatens to take Greenland by force. [Denmark concedes](#) to allow US military bases in Denmark.

Panama: Trump ordered military to plan invasion of Panama to regain control of the Panama Canal. This resulted in [Panama agreeing](#) to allow US military to operate from three bases in the country.

Ukraine: Trump paused aid and intelligence sharing; Trump considered deporting Ukrainian refugees.

Russia: Threatens sanctions over the war with Ukraine.

Iran: Threatens military strike if no nuclear deal made. He [repeats his warning](#) after Israeli strikes. [Trump orders strikes on Iran nuclear sites](#).

Gaza region: Trump is working to [forcibly remove](#) 1,000,000 Palestinians from Gaza.

NATO Allies: Trump threatens not to defend allies if they don't "pay their fair share."

Australia/UK (AUKUS): Nuclear pact threat, review; [Australian perspective here](#).

Full Travel Ban: bans in place due to claims of state-sponsored terrorism or improper vetting structures.

Canada: (2nd entry) 25% trade tariffs; [Trump cites flow of fentanyl across the border as reason](#). Trump [had threatened to annex the country for months](#), before dropping his threats.

China: trade tariffs set at 55% in exchange for [access to rare earth minerals](#).

Colombia: Trump threatened 25% tariffs if Colombia didn't accept deportees.
