## **ISS Expectations**

When students are serving an in-school suspension in Exeter Township Senior High School, the following expectations set forth by the school administration will be followed at all times during the suspension period.

- **Attendance**: Students are expected to arrive on time and remain in the ISS Room for the duration of their suspension period.
- Work assignments: Students must complete academic work or assignments during their suspension period to keep up with their classwork. This could include reading assignments, worksheets, or other educational tasks.
- Reflection and accountability: Students may be asked to reflect on the behavior that led
  to the suspension and take responsibility for their actions. This could involve writing a
  reflection letter, answering a set of restorative practice questions, or participating in a
  discussion about their behavior and its consequences.
- **Behavior and Compliance with Rules:** Students are expected to follow all school rules and guidelines while serving in-school suspension.
  - This includes placing phones in the caddy while in ISS and following directions from supervising staff members.
  - Students are expected to conduct themselves appropriately and respectfully towards staff and other students during the suspension period.
- Use of time constructively: Students should use their time in suspension productively, whether it's completing assigned work, reflecting on their behavior, or finding ways to improve themselves academically or behaviorally.
  - District-issued Chromebooks are the only type of electronic device permitted to be used during in-school suspension and should only be used for academic purposes. Personal laptops or Chromebook use is not permitted.
  - Sleeping during the suspension period or off-task behavior will result in further disciplinary action.
- Traveling to restrooms and the lunchroom: Students are expected to follow the supervising staff member's directions when traveling to and from the restroom and the lunchroom to purchase lunch.
  - Students should remain with the supervising staff member at all times and not wander.

These expectations are intended to help students understand the consequences of their actions, promote accountability and responsibility, and provide opportunities for reflection and growth during the suspension period.
