

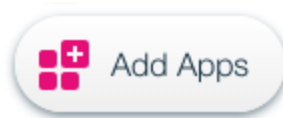
Embedding Powerpoint

Allow users to see your presentation immediately, without having to download an attachment.

Option 1

Convert the Powerpoint to a PDF by selecting “Export” and “PDF.”

While on the page in which you would like to embed the presentation, select the App Market on the left side of the edit screen in Wix by clicking the “Add Apps” button.



Search for “PDF Viewer” in the search box. You are given 2 options, you choose “PDF File Viewer.” Select the “Add to Site” button for the “PDF Viewer” app.

Double click the resulting addition to your page. It contains instructions for uploading the PDF.



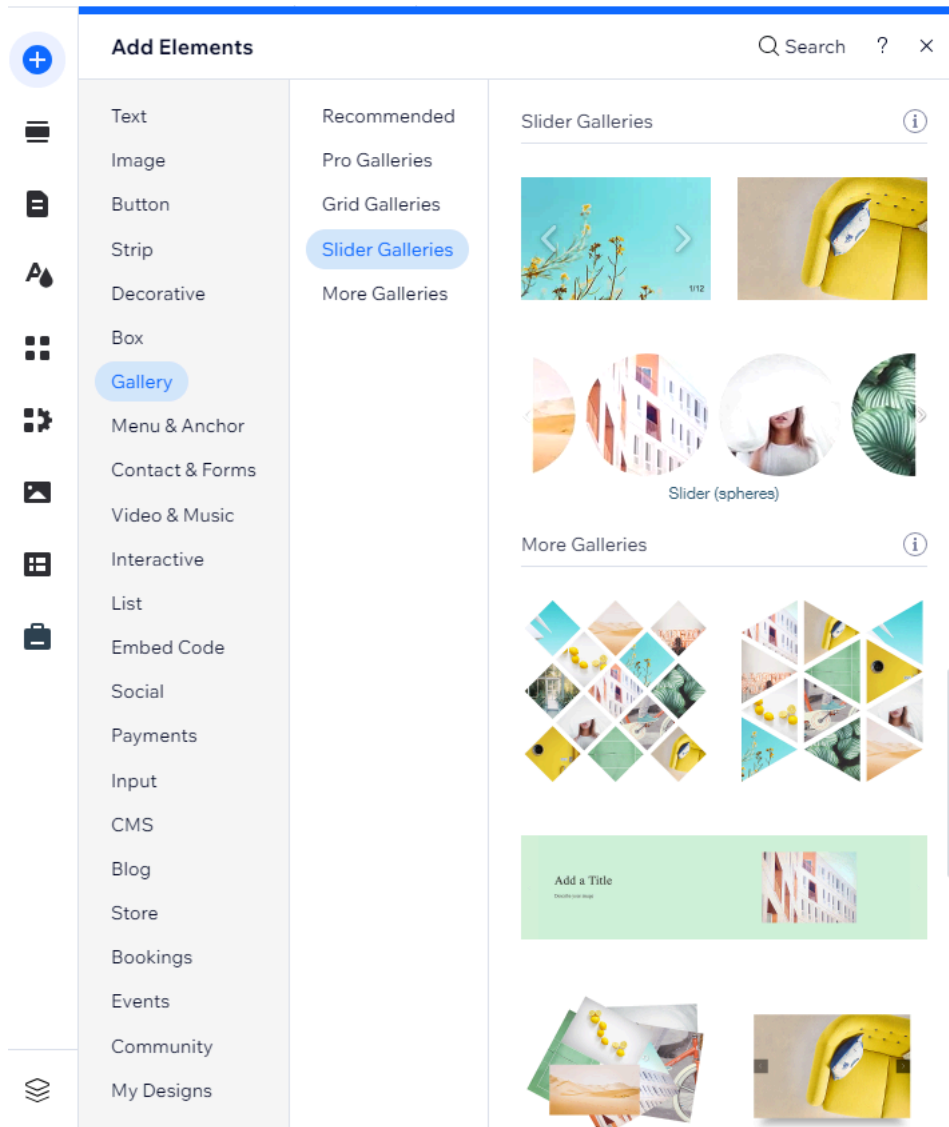
Option 2

Embed the Powerpoint as an image gallery.

Export each slideshow page separately as a JPEG file.

1. In PowerPoint, open your slide presentation, and then open the slide that you want to export.

2. On the File menu, click “Save As.”
3. In the Save as type box, select JPEG File Interchange Format (*.jpg)



On the left side of the page to which you would like to add the presentation, use the “Add” and then “Gallery.” You have

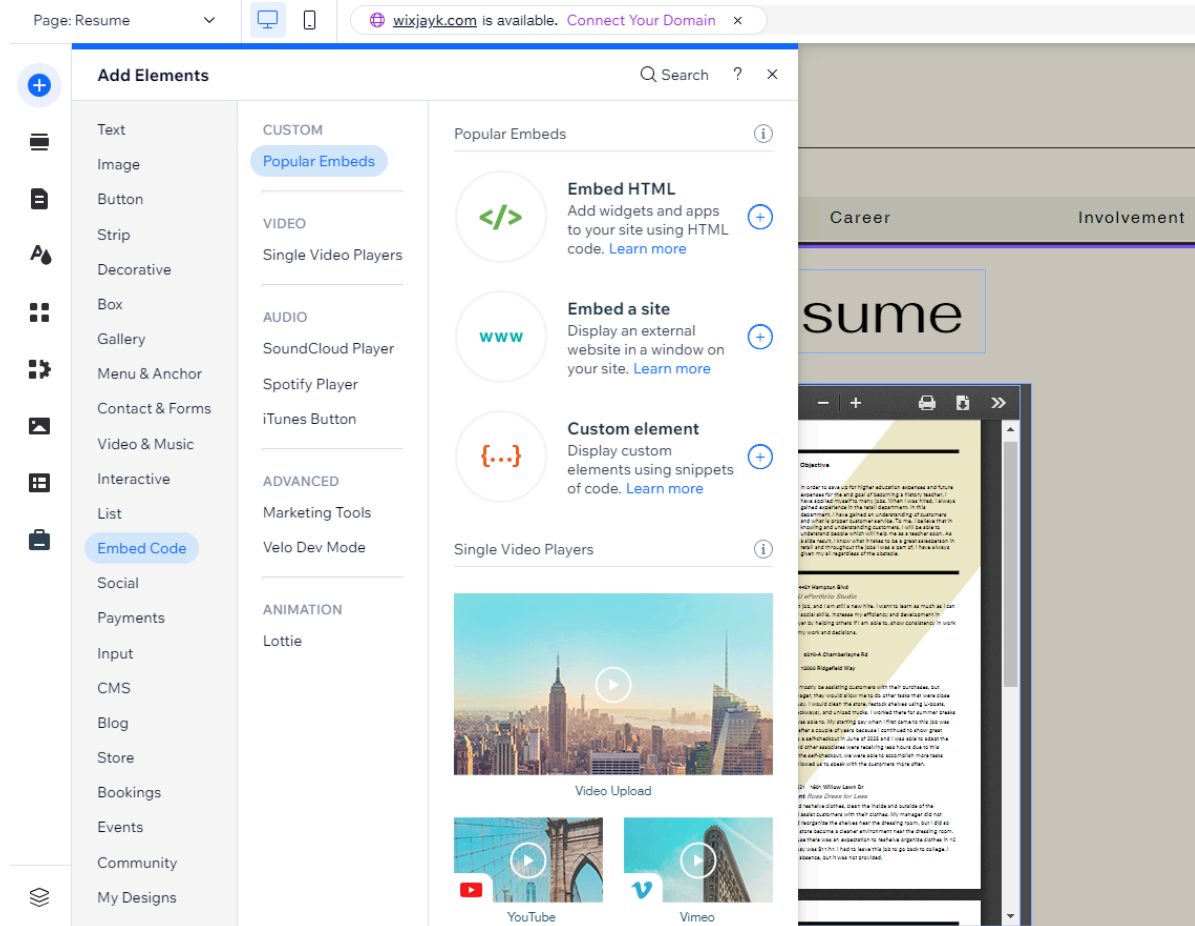
gallery options, choose one. Additionally, you have Gallery display apps as well.

Select the slides, order them, then save.

Option 3

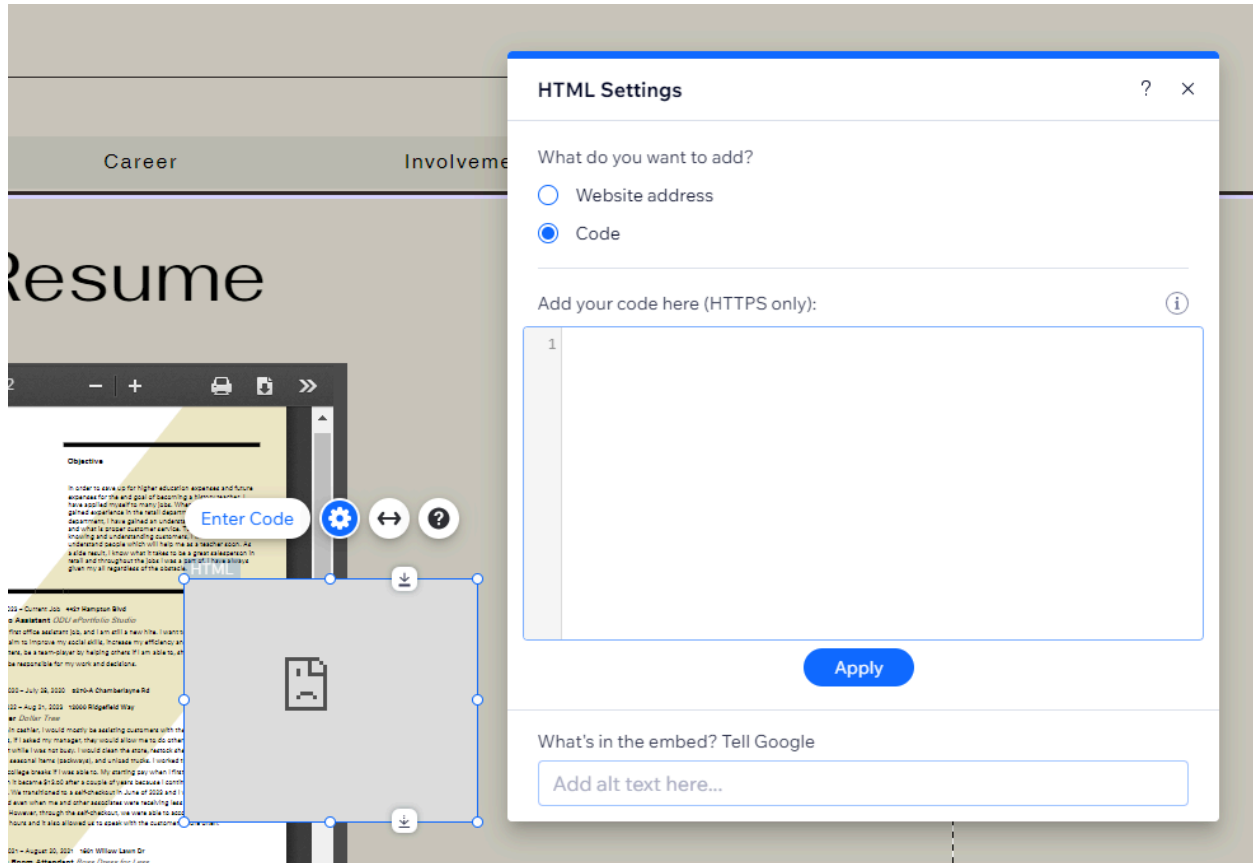
You can embed a Powerpoint by transforming the iFrame App into the Embed Any Powerpoint App.

Click the Add button and navigate to the bottom of the bottom of the menu. Search for the **Embed code** element and then the Embed HTML. Add it to your site.



Click add then it should open the **HTML Settings**. Click **HTML code** under “**What do you want to add?**” and paste your block of code into the box.

Click **Apply** and close the window.



Your PowerPoint Embed will be visible. You can now reposition and adjust the size of your PowerPoint Embed App in the Wix website editor. Don't forget to click **Save** and **Publish** in your Wix website editor to save your changes and publish them on your live website. If you go to your live web page, the PowerPoint Embed App will be visible.

Go to your live Wix web page and **click the settings gear** in the top right corner of your PowerPoint Embed App.

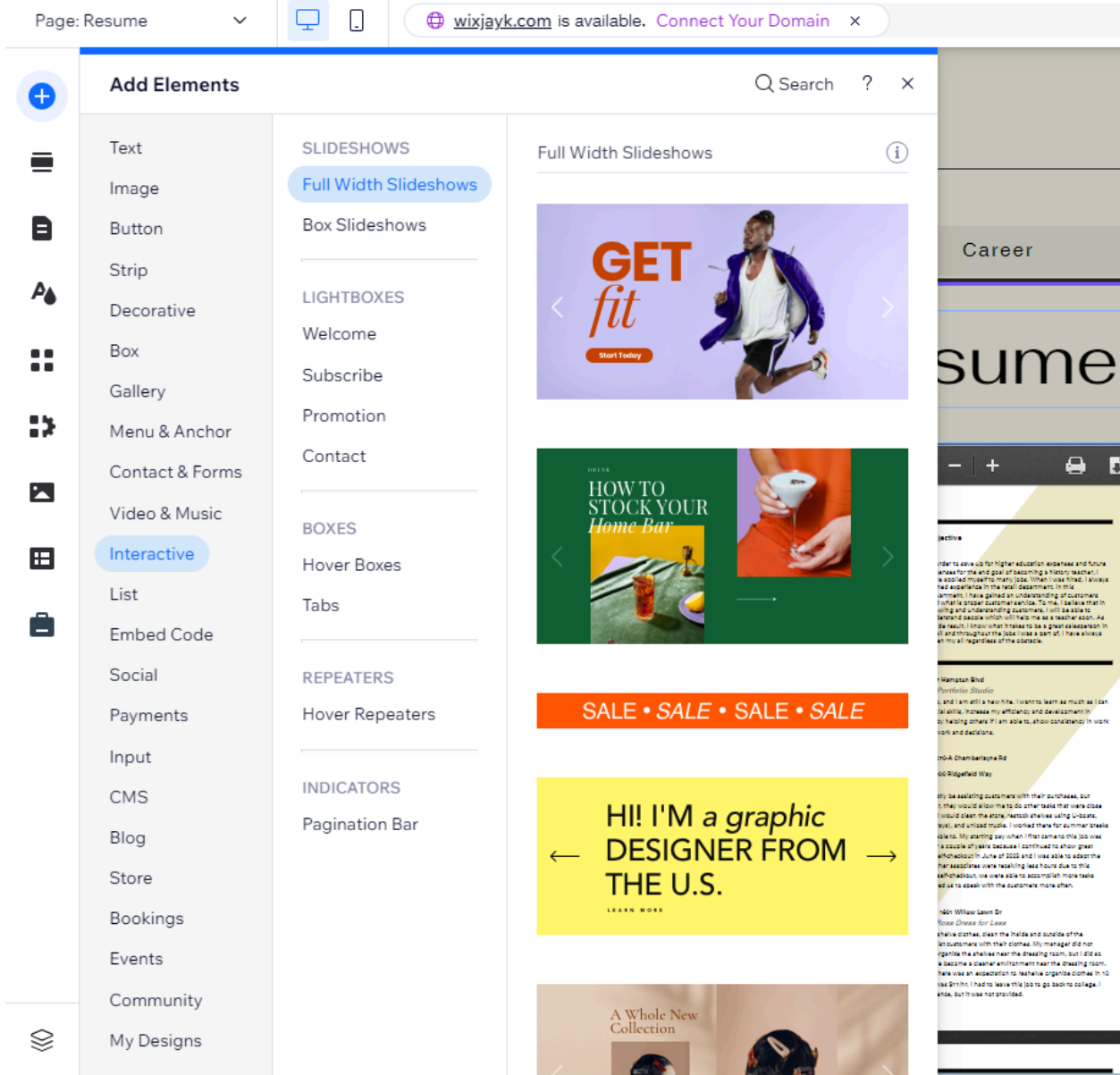
Option 4

You can mimic an embed, turning the Powerpoint into an image slideshow.

Export each slideshow page separately as a JPEG file.

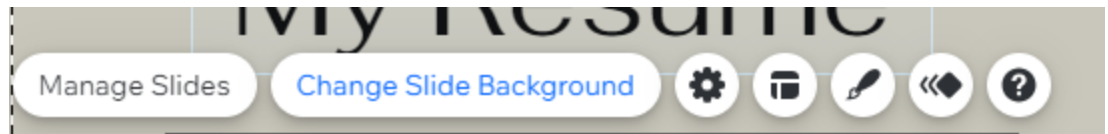
4. In PowerPoint, open your slide presentation, and then open the slide that you want to export.
5. On the File menu, click “Save As.”
6. In the Save as type box, select JPEG File Interchange Format (*.jpg)

On the left side of the page to which you would like to add the presentation, click the Add button. There are three options: Full Width and Box Slideshows. The Box option will be used as an example.



Delete the demo images, then select the settings button to upload your images and add them to the slideshow. You may edit the

order, appearance, size, and placement of the slideshow from there. Alternatively, you can click the Click Slide Background button to change the images.
