

REGULATIONS OF THE FINAL MODULE CONTROL

for assessment in the academic discipline "Psychiatry and narcology"

Conducting remote final module control requires the student to present an identity document. Compilation of the FMC takes place under the condition of direct mutual audiovisual contact (via Skype, Zoom, etc.). FMC includes stages:

1. The answer to the question of test control.
2. The answer to three theoretical questions.
3. The practical part is a written answer to a situational problem with the definition of the leading symptomatology, course of the course, preliminary diagnosis, definition of the main stages of treatment, rehabilitation and prevention.

EVALUATION CRITERIA OF THE FINAL CONTROL

EVALUATION CRITERIA OF COMPONENT REGULATIONS OF THE FINAL CONTROL:

1. TEST CONTROL. The number of tasks for each student is 20 tests (1 test equals 2 points). The examiner or his assistant reads the test questions online and offers 5 answer options (the student must choose 1 correct one). The duration of thinking about the answer does not exceed 30 seconds, otherwise the answer will not be counted.

The maximum grade of the stage is $20 \times 2 = 40$ points.

2. ANSWER TO THE THEORETICAL QUESTION. The examiner asks three theoretical questions according to the list of questions presented at the PMK from various content modules and conducts their subsequent assessment.

The maximum grade of the stage is $3 \times 10 = 30$ points.

3. PRACTICAL PART. At this stage, the student receives a situational task on a separate piece of paper, the question of which he must answer comprehensively - to determine the diagnosis (indicating the clinical form and type of course), the leading syndrome and the main psychopathological symptoms; and if necessary, determine the indications for urgent hospitalization, the observation regime, determine the main directions of treatment, groups of psychotropic drugs prescribed for this pathology, and determine the main directions of rehabilitation and prevention.
