WHAT WE ARE LEARNING THIS WEEK

MATH:

In our first unit we will be reviewing multiplication and division strategies: ratio table, array, and number line. Students will have homework every night unless they complete it in class, we are taking an assessment, on a field study, or have a special activity planned for the day.

LANGUAGE ARTS:

Students will be practicing Reader's Workshop expectations as we continue to read aloud the Sarah Plain and Tall series. Students will be analyzing character's thoughts, actions, and words while making inferences about them.

Grammar:

Students will focus on sentence structure.

SCIENCE:

Students will begin our first unit on the processes that shape the Earth. They will learn about the rock cycle.

SOCIAL STUDIES:

Students will learn about the Preamble to the Constitution. We will be exploring the meaning of the Preamble and create a Preamble for the Upper Elementary.

WRITING:

Students will be writing a mini autobiography about themselves.
