

Heart Drawstring Bag

Notes

- I used a 4.5mm hook and cotton yarn
- This pattern makes a bag that is 4" tall (when sitting up straight and the bottom is flat on the table)
- If you would like the bag to be larger, continue to increase your rounds to the desired size, before moving on to round 5.

Bag:

1. 10 HDC in magic ring, slip stitch to the first stitch to close
2. ch 2, 2HDC in each stitch, sl st closed.
3. ch 2, *2HDC in first stitch, HDC in next stitch*, repeat from * around, sl st closed.
4. ch 2, *2HDC in first stitch, HDC in next 2 stitches*, repeat from * around, sl st closed.
5. Ch 1, sc around, sl st closed.
- 6-13 ch 2, HDC around, sl st closed.
- 14-15 Ch 4, DC into same stitch, *skip one stitch, DC, ch2, DC into next stitch*. Continue around, close w/sl st. into ch space.

Drawstring:

Ch 65, wind into lower "V stitches", knot ends of drawstring together.

Heart:

Create magic circle

Chain 3,

3 Treble Crochet

Chain 1

3 Double Crochet

Chain 1

Treble Crochet 1 {this is the bottom point of the heart}

Chain 1

Double Crochet 3

Chain 1

Treble Crochet 3

Chain 3

Then insert the hook through the center and slip stitch

Pull center closed, tie a knot with end from center and end from sl st.
