Does your child need extra reading help?

Putnam County ESC, in partnership with the Putnam Educational Foundation, offers free, short-term reading support for students reading below grade level in grades 1–4. This program is made possible through a community grant.

About Project MORE

Project MORE is a proven reading intervention that provides one-on-one mentoring for 30 minutes, 3–4 days per week. Sessions focus on reading fluency, comprehension, and overall literacy skills. This support is in addition to classroom instruction.

Program Details

- **Who:** Students in Grades 1-4
- **Cost:** Free
- **Location:** Putnam County ESC, 124 Putnam Parkway, Ottawa, OH
- **Session Dates:** January 26-March 26, 2026
- **Schedule:** Choose 30-minute time slots between 3:30-7:00 PM; Mon-Thurs.
 - It is recommended that students attend 3-4 times per week for the most gains
- **Priority:** Students who are reading below grade level, on an IEP, 504 or RIMP
