Applicants are required to have a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Over 200 scholarships are awarded each year with the average award amounting to \$900. Approximately 80% of the students that applied by June 1st received at least one scholarship award last year. The first round of awards for the coming academic year begins in April. You may receive **more than one** scholarship from the ECC Foundation.
