On behalf of the CARL Board and membership, I would like to formally thank you for your participation on the CARL Open Education Working Group.

The CARL Open Education Working Group (OEWG) group came into being in the first mandate of the OEWG in 2019. The second mandate started May 2020 and ended June 2022.

The activities of the OEWG group included the Community of Practice (CoP) subgroup which started a monthly Cross Canada Coffee Chat (#OECCCC) on various topics of interest to Librarians and other Open education practitioners, such as Open Pedagogy, The OeLe Light group created the online Workshop in a Box training guide for Librarians and others, and

conducted a successful sprint event that will incorporate community feedback for the resource. The Francophone REL facilitates exchanges and take the first steps towards a pan-Canadian "community of practice" on open education and open educational resources among French-speaking or bilingual Canadian post-secondary institutions. As well sub-task groups included work on Indigenous Matters in OE and Open Education Policies.
