All students attend Virtually P.K. On Campus/Off Campus

- Students choose to attend Virtually P.K. 5 days per week on campus or off campus.
- On campus or off campus decisions are made for the duration of the fall semester of 2020-2021.
- Student attendance in both options is expected and monitored.
- Students are expected to uphold guidelines in the Student Code of Conduct.
- Masks/facial coverings are required for all students, teachers, and staff.
- On-campus student cohorts are assigned to one classroom with two teachers.
- Students interact with support personnel as needed.
- All students attend ZOOM meetings with teachers.
- All students complete learning assignments in Canvas.
- All students engage in course-based interactions with peers and teachers online.
- All students make appointments with teachers for virtual coaching and/or virtual instructional support.
- Face-to-face or online ZOOM sessions are scheduled for students requiring special education services, mental health counseling, or tiered instruction.

NOTE: All <u>Campus Procedures</u> will be evaluated and modified to minimize student interaction.
