Informed Consent

Informed Consent is the prescription of medication by a qualified GP without the need for a psychologist diagnosis. The GP is required to fully inform you of the effects, risks, and possible outcomes for the treatment, and provided you accept the given information in totality you may proceed with treatment once an Informed Consent form is individualised and filled out. Informed Consent GPs are not mandatory so you will have to find one that identifies themselves as one. Routes to access GHAT/HRT

There are a few ways to access hormones, here's a brief list of what type of doctor and why you might choose them. No GP should make you wait a certain period of time to verify you are trans or gender diverse. Some GP's might request a psychology sign off on a diagnosis of gender incongruence or gender dysphoria.

Note, for those accessing testosterone under PBS restrictions apply on who can prescribe it.

"Must be treated by a specialist general paediatrician, specialist paediatric endocrinologist, specialist urologist, specialist endocrinologist or a Fellow of the Australasian Chapter of Sexual Health Medicine; or in consultation with one of these specialists; or have an appointment to be assessed by one of these specialists.

The name of the specialist must be included in the authority application."

Ways to access

- 1) GP who prescribe through informed consent
 - a) Note to access Testosterone via PBS it must be prescribed by a sexual health physician with authority
- 2) Sexual health physician
- 3) Endocrinologist

You have a few options, fastest routes are:

- Book an appointment with Clinic 30
- Book an appointment with Dr Fiona Bisshop at Holdsworth House
- For Dr Stuat Aitken at The Evandale Practice call the practise and ask about how to book an appointment with him.
