- 6. Teacher grant committee Kira Heintz Excited to bring teacher grants back. \$8000 set aside from surplus for these grants. Allocating \$4,000 for each half of the school year. 2023 (First Half) submission deadline is November 20th.
- 7. Parcel Tax Erin Miller This will be on the upcoming ballet. Please review your ballot and vote after doing your own research. This Parcel Tax is a way to support our community and our schools. Only 20% of the people in our area have students in our schools, so it will take more than just parents voting for it to pass. There is a committee with phone banking and yard signs, reach out to Erin to get connected. Per property the increase will be \$143 per year for \$2M of funding. Seniors 65+ older are exempt. Mrs Wright has been volunteering her own time for this effort. There are parents at other schools also working to help support. Kay Flodquist Teachers are also phone banking.
