# Visa

### Do I need a visa?

Citizens of any nation can apply for an electronic visa (E-visa) issued by the Vietnamese Immigration Department. Vietnam E-visa is valid for a maximum of 90 days, single or multiple entry. Click here for more details.

Regular passport holders of 25 countries do not need a visa for Vietnam including all South East Asian countries, Japan, South Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Belarus, Chile, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Italy, Norway, Russia, Sweden, United Kingdom. <u>Click here to view the full list</u>.

### What kind of visa do I need?

Visa restrictions range widely and might even depend on the country region speakers come from. In many cases a tourist visa is sufficient and often easier to get. If this is possible for you, please try to proceed this way.
