How To Measure for Blinds and Shades

Then again for height – left, middle and right. Make note for the narrowest width and longest height. You'll also want to measure the window depth to make sure you have enough room. Outside mount blinds go on the wall or molding above the window. You'll need at least 2 inches above the frame for mounting brackets. Add an extra 3 inches to the width and height for ideal light and privacy control.

Small slats tend to look better in a modern space, whereas wider slats give off a more traditional vibe. Measure in centimetres and round down rather than up to ensure that your blinds fit within the recess space and don't snag. With their modern style and easy-to-adjust slats, Venetian blinds are super versatile and will work in just about any room. When viewed with a neutral density filter covering one eye, the white bars appear to slant in the direction toward the covered eye.

The type of window blinds you choose may depend on what the blinds are made of and how or where you plan to use them. Without question, premium wood blinds are at the top tier when it comes to home window treatments. While you can expect a higher price point, you can also count on top quality, classic-looking blinds that will maintain their appearance for years to come. They're lightweight, durable and can be natural or painted in the color of your choice. If you want the look of wood blinds, but they're not in your budget, consider faux wood blinds. Faux wood blinds give you the look of natural wood but cost less.

Difficulty of Repair – Venetian blinds are difficult to repair if the slats are damaged or if the cord gets off track. Safety – Venetian blinds with cords can pose a health hazard for children and small pets who can become tangled in the dangling cord. Style – Venetian blinds work well with a variety of styles from traditional to contemporary. Venetian blind are a favorite with interior designs as they work with such varied design styles. Measure the length of the window from where you want to mount your blinds to the bottom of where you want your blinds to fall.

If you'd prefer your blinds to sit inside the window recess, measure the width at the top, middle and bottom of the recess. All this said, I still went ahead and bought 15 more blinds. I think the first 2 issues could be addressed pretty easily by Graywinds but not really sure yet what's going on with the automation. 1) valance fit window opening perfectly but blind was not centered in the valance. See attached photo look at the top at the valance and then the blind, relative to the window opening.

Decide if you want to use an inside mount or an outside mount. Download this worksheet to record your window details, then bring it in to your local store and select the window treatments that are right for you. Read on for simple instructions on how to measure for blinds. Durable and moisture resistant patented S-curve slats are modern and clean.

If the blinds are not easy to use, again we would not consider them suitable. Make allowances for obstructions like doorknobs, deadbolts or moulding that might get in the way. If you have obstructions, spacer blocks or extension brackets are available to help your blind or shade extend far enough to avoid protrusions.

Modern slat-to-slat closures provide enhanced privacy. However, our venetian blinds come with features to remove the key risks. They are made with safety in mind and come with features to aid this. With a little forethought and planning and making sure you fit all of the safety devices, you will know your venetian blind is safe. They are perfect for filtering the light by tilting the slats, but blinds of this size should only be raised and lowered for cleaning the windows. Raised and lowered regularly will affect the longer term reliability of the blind.
