Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Peaceful Garden Suite ((165932))
- Inks: Lost Lagoon (161678)
- Cardstock: Lost Lagoon (133679), Cloud Cover (165621) and Basic White (166780)
- Designer Paper:
- Accessories: Cloud Cover (165271)
- Tools:
- Miscellaneous: Cake in a Mug kit and wooden spoon

INSTRUCTIONS:



Cloud Cover Cardstock 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 11.
Score long across the top at 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 9 $\frac{1}{2}$.
Lost Lagoon Cardstock 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 4 and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4
DSP grid pattern 1 x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$
DSP blue leaves 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$
Lost Lagoon large label
Basic White small label
Basis White 2 - large diecut leaves
Cloud Cover Large direct leaves
Glimmer peace dove



Glue/Runner DSP to coordinating Lost Lagoon pieces.
Create your cake pocket folding mountian-mountian-valley-mountian.
Adhere your Lost Lagoon and DSP to the front sections.
Secure cake mix with a bow in Cloud Cover Ribbon.



Using Lost Lagoon ink stamp your sentiment on the Basic White label.

Add Cloud Cover leaves to the front of that label off to one side.

One of the Basic White leaves is added under the Lost Lagoon large label.

Create a channel for the wooden spoon using a stack of dimensionals.

Do this on the Lost Lagoon label. How many will depend on the thickness of your spoon. I used three and could have used four. Both top and bottom.

NOTE: I could have used foam adhesive strips. Did not think until typing this up about it.

The other Basic White will be added to look like it is attached to the spoon. However, it will be attached to the Basic White label.

Do a double stack on your Glimmer Dove add so that it looks like it is holding the Cloud Cover leaves.
