### How does the timetable work?

This is your overview for the week - it is set and all subjects and teaching sessions will happen at these set times each day, so feel free to print this out and stick it somewhere to help remind you when you are required to do your learning.

### Where will the timetable be stored online?

We have created an Online Learning Hub website where all items will be stored on this site. Years 1-3 will also use Seesaw to post activities

## What about my child's reading, writing and maths groups and teacher (if different)?

These are also listed on the online learning hub- under groups.

## What about independent work? How will my child know what to do?

The children will be given set tasks by the teachers each day and a follow up task after their zoom lessons. These will be in booklets, worksheets, on Education Perfect for Years 4-6 and in Mathletics and Reading Eggs

### Zoom classes

These are four days a week from 9am -12:30pm - we do this to manage engagement and screen time. Being on zoom is not the same as teaching at school and we want to make sure that we look at the wellbeing of children and teachers.

These sessions are in 30 minute blocks.

### Are the zoom links the same?

Yes, all links are the same, so you just need to click that link to log in to the setup session, reading, writing and maths zooms.

# Will there be additional zooms?
