Fancy Dance





This is a very simple fancy fold. It's just a modified trifold. You need:

Born to Shine Stamps

Layering Ovals and Stitched Stars dies.

Tag die or punch

See a Silhouette DSP

Blueberry Bushel and Whisper White and Silver cardstock

Rhinestones

Tuxedo Black Memento and Blueberry Bushel inkpads

Petal Pink, So Saffron, and Seaside Spray blending pens

- 1. But the Blueberry Bushel 5 ½"x 11" and score at 4 ½" and 8 ¾" and fold.
- 2. Cut the DSP 4 ¼"x 5 ¼" and glue to the inside middle of the card. I cut out a small stitched star, and glued it in the bottom corner on this page.
- 3. Cut another piece of DSP 4 ¼"x 5 ¼" and glue to the front. Use the Layered Oval and cut out the front.
- 4. Cut out several silver Stitched Stars, and adhere all around the front with Dimensionals. Stamp your sentiment with Blueberry Bushel onto Whisper White

- and cut out with the die. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals. Stick some rhinetstones on the tag. I also put a couple on the card front.
- 5. Cut another piece of the DSP 1 ½"x 5 ½" and glue to the little flap. I adhered a tiny Silver Stitched Star to the upper corner of the flap with a dimensional.
- 6. On Whisper White, stamp the little stars all over with Blueberry Bushel. On a different piece, stamp the dancer with black, color her in with the Blending pens, and fussy cut her out.
- 7. Cut out the stars with the Layered Oval Die, and adhere to the flap with Dimensionals so that it will be exactly centered in the oval you cut out from the front when the card is closed. Then adhere the dancer to the oval with Dimensionals.
- 8. To complete the card, stick some Rhinestones on the oval with the dancer.
