Personality

In his public image, Daddy Dearest is presented as a charismatic, altruistic and weirdly prideful and condescending as a performer and a popular model amongst his fanbase and the world itself, making him a very proud and encouraging rockstar towards everyone they look above to, however, the personality he presents himself as a charismatic performer was a facade all along to cover his true personality from the public itself. In reality, Daddy Dearest is a selfish, cruel and hostile figure, as he's done worse from killing anyone who desired the love of his daughter to trapping people in the world of video games. When he found out that Boyfriend is willing to date Girlfriend, he ended up going hostile towards him and tried to defeat him, only for him to be defeated instead. He's also uncaring, as he has attempted on multiple occasions to kill Boyfriend without caring about the consequences it will have on his daughter, making him an hypocrite as he sent Girlfriend into a video game once without realizing that dying in a video game could kill a person in real life as well. His selfish and cruel deeds also makes him overprotective because of Girlfriend. He's shown to be intimidating as shown in Week 5, he was shown holding a Santa hostage by a gunpoint. It's unknown if he realizes the point that pointing the Santa hostage by a gunpoint would affect his public image.

Despite his cruel image being shown to the public, Dearest is still popular till this day like his wife. While he is cruel, he also appears to be somewhat petty, as he hires Pico to kill Boyfriend after the latter beat him in the original source of Week 1. Dearest has hatred towards Boyfriend and because of how much he's resentful towards his daughter's partner, he gives him pain in such sadistic way, showing his sadistic side, like the way of how he have his own enjoyments about torturing and seeing his victims in pain and yet, he can be easily annoyed when it comes to Boyfriend. However, he is not as ill-willed as his wife Mommy Mearest, who's far worse than him, willing to keep Girlfriend safe. Despite being cruel and uncaring, he still seems to care for Girlfriend, showing his nice-guy side towards her. Yet, he's manipulative as he was able to lie to Girlfriend about humans liking plane crashes and other such lies as well.

In Future Night Funkin', Dearest still has his old personality but with add-ons and differences. For this version of Daddy Dearest, in his public image, is still being presented as a charismatic, altruistic and weirdly prideful and condescending as a performer and a popular model amongst his fanbase and the world itself, making him a very proud and encouraging rockstar towards everyone they look above to, however, his presentation to the public is still a facade to the public itself. In reality, he's still in his selfish, cruel and hostile personality and is highly manipulative than his original self, and uses this trait to get Boyfriend tricked by his lies (because of his intelligence), and has a flamboyant demeanor

due to his rich life, making him greedy at the same time. This would explain why his family's outfit is at an expensive cost. As he's an intimidating and threatening person, he always threatens his henchmen as he treats them worse than good but the most specific he threatens is Boyfriend, his arch-nemesis, as he treats him worse as well but Boyfriend just blows a raspberry and call it for a day without the point that Boyfriend is going to face any type of consequences from the demonic ex-rockstar. Because his son-in-law is his arch-nemesis, he hates him so much like how he hates him in the original game and as each year passed by, his hatred towards BF became more and more intense, to the point where just talking about him is enough for him to have explosive bursts of anger, much to his annoyance. When he found out that Boyfriend is willing to marry Girlfriend, he ends up jumping into the scene and tries to kill him out of hostility while uncaring the fact that killing him would bring consequences on his daughter, making him a hypocrite and also overprotective as he never wants to have anyone to desire the love of his daughter but this would mean killing those who desires love for Girlfriend out of overprotectiveness.

Daddy Dearest's cruelty and hostility goes more further in Future Night Funkin' as he beats up Pico out of sheer rage after capturing him and even states the point that he shouldn't have hired people who knows Boyfriend well and considers him as his friend. He beats up Darnell and Nene out of sheer rage as well after capturing him due to the same reason as Pico. His pettiness goes much further as he implements a fire inside his victim's bodies, which turns out to be his magic to turn normal species into remorseless killing machines and loyal servants to Daddy Dearest while unknowingly becoming cursed demons and being forced to live as a demon. Due to this, he's extremely sadistic when it comes to sending out cursed victims to kill the target he despises the most, as he sends out cursed Pico to kill Boyfriend, so Boyfriend can't marry his daughter, then sends out cursed Darnell and Nene to kill Pico for not confirming BF's dead body. He doesn't care about the consequences that would be brought upon his daughter when her loved ones are killed in front of her. He's short-tempered whenever things don't go his own way and kills one of his henchmen as he finds out the result being a complete failure.

In the present day of Future Night Funkin', after finally decided to let Girlfriend go and marry Boyfriend to live in her happy life forever, Daddy Dearest became a miserable and depressed figure in the state of being unmotivated to do anything, just staying in home out of his remorse to believe that letting Girlfriend marry Boyfriend is considered his worst mistake he ever made. Due to his depression and miserability, he smokes out of shame and even believes to the point that he's a constant failure to his daughter and sometimes, violently hallucinates to believe that he hasn't retired from being a rockstar and still being the proud performer he is but this isn't the case as he hallucinates himself talking to a darker reflection of himself, taunting him for his failures or see Girlfriend leaving the Dearest Family with Boyfriend and making her own family she never had. He still hates Boyfriend but is no longer motivated to kill him because of his depression, only to trash talk each other during phone calls but Boyfriend gets the best out of him, much to his annoyance. His depression even worsens to the point that his cruelty, selfishness and hostility goes more further ahead, starting to become more greedy and additionally, arrogant and self-centered, viewing his fame and public image as more important than his own flesh and blood, but when facing defeat, he's a complete and very sore loser who's completely immature and competitive, almost showing his true nature to the public. Due to his self-centered personality, he can be

seen as an insecure and spoiled man-child brat and as an self-centered person that he is, he's utterly obsessed with his fame and fortune.

When Grace became a 19 year old adult, he believed that he found himself a new purpose; a purpose to kill Grace in order to make Boyfriend express devastation on his face and how he will react to her death. He even believes to the point that killing Grace and making Boyfriend express devastation in any way possible would make Dearest become happy and act like his normal self once again. Due to his huge belief that he found his new purpose, he started to adopt a facade personality, where he's friendly and happy towards Girlfriend and her family, making them believe that Dearest is finally able to cope with his depression and able to move on and start a better life under a better personality, however, this is all a utter lie and facade, making them unaware of his facade personality. Whenever he's alone with Grace, he starts with his facade look until using old personality, where he used to be before Girlfriend and Boyfriend got the opportunity to be happily married, and uses it to kill Grace to fulfill his goal to make Boyfriend miserable. His desire to kill Grace means that he's no longer after Boyfriend's death but rather after Boyfriend's misery. Unfortunately for Dearest, he doesn't seem to realize that using a facade and his old personality don't seem to cope with his depression but rather, worsening his depression and mental health, almost making him look like a very insane person that seems to look fine while unknowingly losing his mind. He could potentially break down both mentally and villainously if he loses all of his cool, revealing his true nature to the public and destroying his entire image as the prideful and proud performer he used to be. He is shown to be paranoid, from the point of believing that Grace's girlfriend, Nerissa, is one of her bodyguards, leading him to try to kill her.

Boyfriend

Boyfriend is Daddy Dearest's son-in-law and his very first arch-nemesis, who wants him dead, as he often tries to kill him when the couple are trying to enjoy spending time together due to how Dearest is highly overprotective of his daughter. Even though Daddy Dearest is a powerful and an evil demon, Boyfriend is not afraid to face off against him in rap battles in order to be allowed to date his daughter. Despite his hatred for Boyfriend, Dearest compliments the protagonist and decides to let him have [blank] with Girlfriend and be part of the Dearest Family, however, the part of becoming a Dearest Family Member was a trap while Boyfriend didn't seem to notice at all. 10 years later, Daddy Dearest still hates Boyfriend and when he heard that he's going to marry Girlfriend through her request, he attempted to prevent it from happening but failed. He even tried to get rid of him by hiring assassins to eliminate him but failed as well and wouldn't give up on it, however, this didn't last long enough after he finally decided to let Boyfriend marry Girlfriend happily forever, live in a happy marriage life and give birth to twin children 9 months later. Dearest later became miserable of how he finally decided to let him be her husband and fell into depression, believing the fact that letting Boyfriend marry Girlfriend was one of the worst decisions he ever made. Boyfriend seems to be aware of his depression, however, he won't go too far

from making fun of his depression as he'll try to cheer him up despite how he's been hated for all these days.

Grace

Grace is Dearest's secondborn and younger twin granddaughter but like Keith, who started hating his grandparents for having a history containing crimes they committed, Grace was a different case where she always liked to see her grandparents when Girlfriend would bring her and Keith to see them. As time started to pass by with Grace starting to grow up into a 19 year old young adult, Dearest believed that he found a new purpose; his new purpose is to kill Grace in order to make Boyfriend express devastation on his face and how he will react to her death. It's also believed that killing Grace and making Boyfriend express devastation in any way possible would make Dearest become happy and act like his normal self once again. Grace, on the other hand, is unknown if she is aware of the fact that Dearest is trying to kill her while she still sees him as her grandfather. It's stated that Grace always talks about how she'll roast her demonic grandparents whenever she's alone with Boyfriend, much to the point that Boyfriend wants her to tone it down because they're fallen into a state of depression. If Grace finds out that Dearest wants her dead, she would just not care and call it for a day or simply, just go cocky over it.

Henchmen

Henchmen are Dearest's servants and also, servants for the Dearest Family as the entirety. As they're servants to the Dearest Family, the Henchmen are shown to be loyal and obedient to them and including Girlfriend, willing to protect her at any cost despite their low intelligence. Dearest and his Henchmen share the same hatred for Boyfriend but after the Dearest Family grew depressed over letting Girlfriend go to have her own life, he gave up most of his henchmen to Boyfriend and Girlfriend and the Henchmen, who were given up by the former, started to become loyal servants as the entirety to Boyfriend and started to like him more for treating them better than how the Dearest Family treated them before Boyfriend and Girlfriend took over. They even started to compare Boyfriend's treatment towards the Henchmen and the Dearest Family (excluding Girlfriend)'s treatment towards the Henchmen. It's possible that Dearest created them to protect Girlfriend, however, the official Friday Night Funkin' source has yet to confirm if they're Dearest's creation.

Keith

Keith is Dearest's firstborn and older twin grandson but like Grace, who likes her demonic grandparents while seemingly unaware of their history containing their crimes, Keith was a

different case where he started to hate his grandparents due to his discovery about his history containing the crimes they committed when he was 10 years old and unappreciated his mother whenever she would bring him and Grace to see them. Keith was convinced by Girlfriend to stop hating them due to his grandparents growing depressed after his mother was finally free from the family's grasp and wanted to change his mind. Even after this, Keith still didn't change his mind and Girlfriend decided to let him choose to either continue or stop. As time started to pass by with Grace starting to grow up into a 19 year old young adult, Dearest believed that he found a new purpose; his new purpose is to kill Grace in order to make Boyfriend express devastation on his face and how he will react to her death. It's also believed that killing Grace and making Boyfriend express devastation in any way possible would make Dearest become happy and act like his normal self once again. While Grace doesn't seem to be aware of the fact that Dearest is trying to kill her for his satisfaction, Keith, on the other hand, is aware of this fact and would walk around and stick with Grace as some type of her guardian and looking around the place if he sees Dearest or his Henchmen, trying to kill her. After entering college, Keith became worried because he separated himself from his family to improve his art skills and started using his magic to spectate his family, especially Grace and Dearest. His confrontation with Dearest would be considered violent.

Mommy Mearest

Mommy Mearest is Dearest's wife and they're close to each other as they share the same hatred towards Boyfriend, but also highly overprotective of Girlfriend at the same time, and because they hate Boyfriend, they're willing to kill Boyfriend while not caring about the consequences that will affect on Girlfriend, showing the fact that they work together to attempt kill Boyfriend, no matter what and while being hypocrites towards Girlfriend. In Dearest's early years prior to his retirement, he possibly met Mearest through the music business due to the duo being singers in their youth. Because they hate Boyfriend, they share experiences together about their future son-in-law and how [blank]ty their days were since he became a new member of the Dearest Family. 10 years later, the duo were still being the same overprotective family for Girlfriend, the main example being attempting to prevent her from marrying Boyfriend but failed, however, this didn't last long enough after they finally decided to let Girlfriend go fully and be around with Boyfriend happily forever, live in a happy marriage life and give birth to twin children 9 months later. Similar to Dearest, Mearest later became miserable of how she finally decided to let her go and fell into depression, believing the fact that letting Girlfriend go was one of the worst decisions she ever made. They even become unmotivated to do anything in their life and just simply chill at home.

Nerissa Aurora Young

While Dearest and Nerissa never got to interact with each other, he only did was to find out that Grace has a girlfriend and hangs out a lot with her and believed that she's also one of Boyfriend's bodyguards. This led Dearest to try to kill her too, however, it's unknown if Nerissa is aware of this as well.

Pico

Pico is one of Dearest's first very hired and skilled hitmen and one of his contract killers, tasking him with killing Boyfriend after the latter humiliated him during the original source of Week 1. However, even after he finds out that Pico decides to betray the ex-rockstar and spare Boyfriend upon discovering that his target was his ex all along, Dearest employs Pico again to confirm his dead body without a second thought. Employing him again was his worst decision as Pico betrays Dearest once more and saves Boyfriend's life from the army of Tankmen. As a result, Dearest is full of anger and makes Pico, Darnell and Nene penniless, leaving Pico to run away from his danger while being in deep trouble with the ex-rockstar himself. 10 years later, Pico is now Daddy Dearest's secondary arch-nemesis for becoming fully loyal towards Boyfriend and bodyguarding the former and Girlfriend as well but after Boyfriend finally got to marry Girlfriend and give birth to their twin children after 9 months, Dearest no longer seems to go after Pico or any of his former employees anymore due to his motivation to take action in its low percentage, presumably making Pico his former arch-nemesis. - Dearest's newer design is fusion based on Jurard T Rexford and Ouro Kronii, who are both from Hololive while debuting as a gen member from their respective EN branches on a different date and year.
 - Jurard debuted as the 3rd gen member of Holostars ENGLISH ARMIS on November 17th, 2023 while Kronii debuted as the 2nd gen member of Hololive ENGLISH Promise on August 23rd, 2021.
 - Prior to Promise, she was a member of Council and the unit was alternatively called CouncilRyS and also included Tsukumo Sana for a short time before she retired.
 - Dearest's footwear is based on Jurard's footwear while the bronze wrists are based on Kronii's fourth 2D costume.
 - The suit design is shown to be loosely based on Jurard's as well.
 - Dearest's suit design in My Demons is based on Jurard's while the cape design is based on Dio's design prior to becoming a vampire.

- Dearest's newer look is based on his appearance in a canceled Friday Night Funkin' mod titled, Static Memories. It's also a mod where he loses Girlfriend and becomes depressed over the loss of his daughter from an unknown incident.
 - This is notable where Dearest is smoking a cigarette, possessing dark eye circles and has a messy hairstyle.
 - Unlike Static Memories' Dearest, who became depressed and started smoking due to his loss of Girlfriend, Future Night Funkin's Dearest became depressed and started smoking because he finally decided to let Girlfriend marry Boyfriend and live a happy life forever.
 - Static Memories' Dearest has his chest hair being covered while FutureNF's Dearest has his chest hair being revealed.
 - This is notable as he doesn't have a necktie.
 - This may also be part of his depression or simply, he just doesn't want to wear a tie anymore.
 - Daddy Dearest is one of the Future Night Funkin' characters to be designed after a Virtual Streamer.
 - He's also one of the characters to be a fusion of two designs.
 - His My Demons design is the only exception as it's solely based on Jurard's only.
- From the previous document, his old design had a ring on his finger but in both his new design and his exclusive design, the ring is removed.
- Dearest's new render is based on Garcello's render as seen in the Hazy River wiki page.
