### Week 1

2. Listen & follow along while looking at the score. [YouTube](#) (choir) or [Youtube](#) (Muscores)
  - a. Learn the text: "Repeat after me." Speak one phrase at a time, and have your kids repeat it back to you. Maybe listen every day, but only drill a few lines each day.
  - b. Sing along/Listen

2. Different sources claim different authors, but as far as I can tell, the text was written by John Scheffler (pen name [Angelus Silesius](#), (1624-1677) a convert to the Faith. The version we are learning was paraphrased by Sr. Jeanne Marie from a translation by Robinson Potter Dunn (1825-1867). The arranger the harmonization is by Nicola A. Montani for the St. Gregory Hymnal (1920.)

### Week 3

3. For younger children, print a Holy Communion [coloring page](#)
4. Work on copywork/verse illustrations.
