KAZAKHSTAN INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION “INTERNATIONAL AUTO EXPO 2025”

Atakent KCBC, Almaty, Republic of Kazakhstan

On October 15 to 17, the Kazakhstan International Exhibition of Auto Parts, Components, Accessories, and Equipment for Auto Service – “**International Auto Expo 2025**” – will be held at the Atakent Kazakhstan Center for Business Cooperation with the official support of the Ministry of Industry and Infrastructure Development of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The event is organized by Atakent-Expo International Exhibition Company.

The main objectives of the Exhibition are: to demonstrate the potential of Kazakhstani companies, new products and services; to create opportunities for participants to establish new business contacts in the production and supply of auto components and spare parts, as well as equipment for the automotive industry and service enterprises.

Visiting the Exhibition offers an opportunity to find suppliers interested in direct cooperation with vendors from different regions, as well as to expand and renew the range of goods and services offered, within three days only.

Companies from Kazakhstan, the People’s Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Germany, and Russia will demonstrate their products and services during the Exhibition. Participants include suppliers and manufacturers of automotive components, accessories, and car wash equipment. A new exhibition segment – electric motorcycles, bicycles, tricycles, and scooters – will also be introduced.

On the outdoor area in front of the pavilion, visitors will be able to get acquainted with Valmo KZ LLP, a company specializing in the sale of Chinese special machinery.

As part of the Exhibition’s Business Program, a Round Table Discussion “The Future of Auto Components and Electric Vehicle Technologies: Localization, Innovation, and Sustainable Development in Central Asia” will be held on October 15. The event will be attended by the official delegation of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade, Jiangsu Sub-Council (CCPIT Jiangsu), and the Almaty Chamber of Entrepreneurs. The delegation includes official representatives of the Council, as well as around 20 executives from Chinese companies interested in establishing business contacts and developing cooperation with Kazakhstani entrepreneurs. The discussion will focus on the localization of auto component manufacturing, the development of electric transport, and the creation of a sustainable manufacturing ecosystem in the region.

In addition, the Exhibition will feature sectoral workshops and technical presentations, where companies’ specialists will introduce new technologies, products, and solutions for the automotive business.

The organizers do hope that automotive industry professionals will find reliable business partners to run a joint business and develop mutually beneficial cooperation for the future.
