- 2. Spend time in prayer asking God to reveal any "idols" in your life that you may be prioritizing over Him.
- 4. Practice sharing your faith with a friend or family member this week, even if it feels uncomfortable.
- 5. Reflect on a past trial in your life. Write down ways you saw God's presence during that time, even if the outcome wasn't what you hoped for.
