



Mickey Mouse Park

Guests enter the front of the park through a classic large “studio gate.” The outer fencing surrounding the front end of the park features numerous ornate decorative iron “W” emblems. The top of the fencing forms a classic “mouse ears” shape.

Entering the park, guests find themselves in a turn of the previous century town in a constant state of celebration. Cast Members have dozens of roles here, including shop owners, police officers, and train conductors.

The Carolwood Pacific Miniature Railroad is the main attraction of the entry land. This small scale railway takes guests all over Mickey Mouse Park, crossing over a small fabricated lake and including a second stop near the entrance to the museum.

Multiple shops and other functional buildings line the various “streets” of the park. These include an ice cream shop, a pretzel and bagel shop, a coffee shop, a functional police station that serves as the park’s lost and found, and storefronts that sell park merchandise and other souvenirs.

On the aforementioned lake, guests may rent canoes and other self propelled water vessels. A small island in the middle of the lake has numerous figures of wildlife.

A stroll to the other side of the lake will bring guests to the “residential” street. Here are numerous where Disney characters live. This functions as the primary character meet and greet area. Although some characters will also occasionally be found walking around the town streets.

An expansive green space serves as an actual park and picnic ground for guests to rest and relax. This space has playground equipment including slides and swings.

On the other side of the picnic grounds, near the Museum entrance, guests will find a carousel, miniature ferris wheel, and a vintage car ride that winds its way around the green space.

Finally, a boulevard near the Museum features statues of Walt Disney, Roy Disney, Card Walker, Marc Davis, Marty Sklar, Rolly Crump, Tony Baxter, Joe Rhode, Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse. Each has a small plaque that offers brief insight into each individual's contributions to Disney Parks and the company as a whole.
