"(1) Our current childcare system is grossly unaffordable market-based one, under which working families can expect to pay a third of their annual household paycheck on childcare alone.

(2)In adequacy of our current childcare system is also deomnstrated by the conditions of childcare workers and providers. In california unorganized childcare workers are paid a median wage of \$23,760.

Universal childcare does not currently exist in Los Angeles, or anywhere in the country. Our society must intentionally decide to put the needs of children, their families, and their teachers before the needs of capital, and universal childcare exemplifies the heart of this urgent task.
