

VOTING PROCEDURES

We will use “unanimous consent” as much as possible to move through the meeting as quickly as possible. This means those agenda items for which this is appropriate will be passed without calling for a vote unless there is an objection. Please keep in mind that a question regarding a point of parliamentary procedure or a detail in a report is not an objection.

If there are no objections, a report will be accepted as submitted. To object, click on the “yes” icon or for a phone that does not have that feature, enter “* (star) 9” on the telephone keypad. Again, this is only if there is an objection to a report.

In the case of contested elections, delegates will be emailed a link to the Election Buddy app. Voting in this app will remain open until 10 minutes after the conclusion of the last candidate’s speech at the District Council Meeting. Delegates may change their vote after entering it in the app, but once the vote has been submitted, it is final.

In the case of uncontested elections, “unanimous consent” will be used.
