- **Robust English Language Program & Instruction** - KCIA has an extensive, rigorous, and robust K-8 English Language Program. We have highly trained and experienced English language development teachers/specialists equipped to support our students' language needs. Translators support newcomer students who need enriched language instruction.
- **Professional Development** - KCIA prioritizes professional growth for teachers. Weekly professional development for staff focuses on topics such as engagement strategies, modifying/scaffolding instruction, data analysis, and classroom management strategies. KCIA teachers deeply value the development they receive and they see their feedback reflected in the content of future professional learning.
- **Instructional Coaching Model** - Every teacher at KCIA receives coaching and support to improve their practice. Our first and second year teachers receive additional training/support through mentorship and coaching. Collaboration is key at KCIA and we encourage teachers to learn from each other daily.
