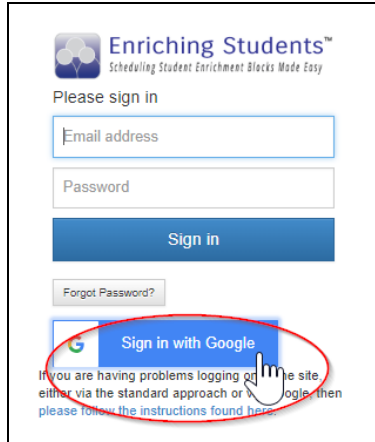


Enriching Students - Teacher Login with Google

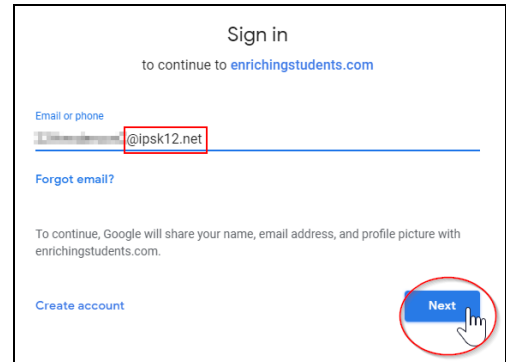
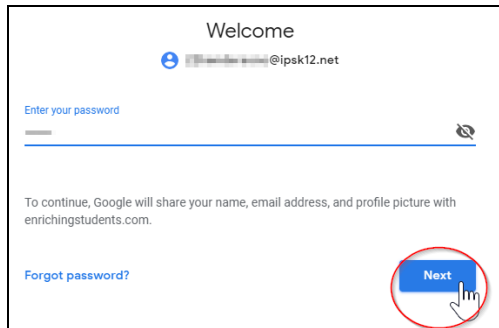
Go to <https://app.enrichingstudents.com> to sign in to Enriching Students.

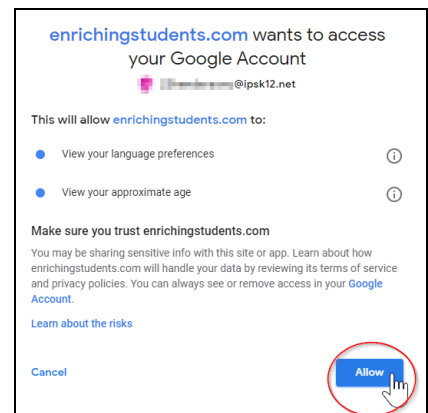
Enter your IPS password.
