Career Cluster	Route Description
Route 1 - Agriculture	Explore exciting career paths in modern agriculture on this field trip! Discover how technology, like drones, robotics, and GPS systems, is revolutionizing farming and animal care while creating diverse opportunities in this vital industry. See firsthand how innovation is shaping the future of food production.
Route 2 - Arts/Theater Focus UWM Peck School of the Arts & Milwaukee Rep	If you are interested in the theatrical performing arts, join our tour of the Peck School of the Arts at the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee. For this experience, students will see the various areas of study available at UWM for the performing arts, and if interested, students will have the opportunity to take a college-level beginning dance class. For the afternoon, students will visit a local Milwaukee Theater. Theater staff will be on hand to discuss stagecraft and marketing careers within the theater world.
Route 3 - Arts/AV/Communications - Arts/Design Focus Theatrical Arts Presentation UW Milwaukee Art Department Third Ward	If you are a creative person who enjoys art and design, join our group to learn about a variety of visual art careers. We'll hear about art opportunities in theatrical productions, visit the murals at Black Cat Alley, tour the visual art department at the Peck School of the Arts at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, and visit Milwaukee's Third Ward to see art galleries and art-related businesses.
Route 4 - Business/Real Estate Real Estate location ORBIS Corporation UW-Whitewater College of Business	This route will be interacting with a local real estate agent from First Weber! We will also visit ORBIS Corporation to hear from different departments. Afterwards, we will tour the UW-Whitewater College of Business.
Route 5 - Computer Science/IT	From software programming to video game development and artificial intelligence to cyber security, computing careers are the way of the present and future!  Learn about computing careers in networking, programming, and hardware, as well as explore post-secondary career options in cybersecurity, analytics, front-end development, and more.
Route 6 - Construction Ironworkers Local 8 - "Cowboys of the Sky" Carpenters Training Center	Students will have the opportunity to tour the IronWorkers Local 8 "Cowboys of the Sky" facility. Students will be led through hands-on activities pertaining to the ironworker trade. Lunch will be provided by the Ironworkers Local 8. We will also learn about the Carpentry Trades by touring the local carpenter's union training center. Students will have the opportunity to speak with trades leaders in each of these careers and will also have the opportunity to see the training facilities that go along with each trade.
Route 7 - Education Elementary/Middle School UW-Whitewater - Education	There's no better way to see if you're interested in working with children to dive right in and gain some experience. Join us for a trip to Nature Hill Intermediate School to work with students on a variety of activities. We'll also visit a college for lunch, a tour, and see what it takes to join the Education pathway.

We will tour local businesses Ace Precision & MSI General. In the afternoon, we'll travel to Brookfield to see Milwaukee Tool's engineering department.
Route 9 - Finance UW-Madison UW-Athletic Office	Come see what the University of Wisconsin-Madison's athletic department does with its accounting and finance! We will tour the College of Business at UW-Madison to see what its campus has to offer prospective college students!

Route 10 - Health Sciences-Medical Edgewood College VA Hospital (Madison)	Tour Edgewood College's School of Nursing and see all their program has to offer. You will also get an overall tour of the Edgewood College Campus, a great, smaller university option in Downtown Madison. Our next stop will be the VA Hospital in Madison to learn about how nurses are used in their facility. This will include time in their simulation lab and hands-on nursing experience. We will enjoy lunch in Madison after our tour of the VA.
Route 11 - Health Sciences-Physical Training & Wellness Salt Spot Tricia's Troops Yoga Next Level	Interested in a career in the healthcare field but not looking for a job in a hospital? Join us as we discover how fitness and health go hand in hand. Hear more about natural health and wellness, visit a yoga studio, and connect with a fitness center to see which career might be a fit for you.
Route 12 - Hospitality Concordia University Mitchell Domes	We will visit Concordia University—Wisconsin to learn more about their Hospitality and Event Business degree (Hospitality Management) and take a campus tour. We will then stop for lunch, followed by a visit to the Mitchell Domes to tour that site and learn more about hospitality careers with Zilli Hospitality Group.
Route 13 - Human Services - Cosmetology OHS - Esthetician, WCTC Cosmetology, Antons	Curious about a career in cosmetology? Join us on a trip to explore the field! We'll start with learning about estheticians, then visit WCTC's hair salon and program. After lunch, we'll tour the hair and medispa at Anton's.
Route 14 - Human Services - Mental Wellness Rogers Memorial Hospital Children's Wisconsin	This trip allows participants to explore the field of Mental Health at Rogers Memorial Hospital (Oconomowoc) and Children's Wisconsin (Wauwatosa). We will explore the use of new therapies to help reduce anxiety and improve mental and physical well-being. Explore all things mental health as a potential career field!
Route 15 - Public Safety Oconomowoc Police Department Western Lakes Fire Department WCTC - Fire & Police Programs	Interested in law enforcement or fire protective services? Join this group to see potential careers and learn more about what education/training is needed to be a first responder!
Route 16 - Law Federal Courthouse	The Federal Courthouse in Milwaukee provides an opportunity to see many different careers connected with the Law/Government on the federal level. Join this group and learn more about these possibilities!
Route 17 - Manufacturing Steamfitters Local 601	We will tour a post-secondary training facility (Union hall or Technical college) and have a chance to tour a place of industry to see Welding, Machining, and Fabrication in a real-world environment.
Route 18 - Marketing/Communications Marcus's premiere Theatre (Majestic) Clearwing Productions Marquette Communications	Join us for an exciting, full-day exploration into the fast-paced world of Marketing and Communications! This immersive experience will take students behind the scenes of digital production studios, marketing agencies, and broadcasting hubs to discover how creative ideas come to life and reach global audiences.

We'll finish with a visit to the General Mitchell Field Fire Department for aviation-related incidents.
Route 21 - Music Industry and Education Brass Bell Music Store - Glendale UW Milwaukee - Peck School of the Arts	Curious about the music industry in performance, audio engineering, composition, or music education? We will be exploring music from the lens of a business owner, a professional musician and player, a private lesson teacher, an instrument repair technician, an audio engineer, and many other music-related careers! Students who have joined us have let us know how surprised they were with how much money is made in this part of the music industry! We will also check out The Peck School of the Arts on the East side of Milwaukee to learn more about what it's like to attend a rigorous music program, meet some current students, check out some music major classes, and have a chance to ask questions and see a window into what it's like to be a music major!
