

NSU Health and Human Performance Program Data

The Health and Human Performance program at NSU is accredited by the Committee on Accreditation for the Exercise Sciences (CoAES), under the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP). This accreditation is reviewed and renewed annually, ensuring that the program continues to meet the rigorous standards set by the profession.

As part of the accreditation process, the department is required to collect and analyze data related to student performance and satisfaction, as well as feedback from faculty, alumni, and employers. This ongoing evaluation supports continuous improvement and helps ensure that the educational experience remains aligned with industry expectations.

Retention Rates:

Students are tracked from year to year after program admittance to determine the retention rate:

2025-2026: 69%

2024-2025: 71%

2023-2024: 79%

2022-2023: 82%

2021-2022: 73%

Graduation Rates:

Graduation rates are calculated as the percentage of admitted students who graduate within 6 years of admission to NSU

2025-2026: 72%

2024-2025: 64.7%

Graduate Placement Rates

Students enrolled in graduate school or employed within one year of graduation:

2025-2026: 100%

2024-2025: 90%

2023-2024: 83%

Graduate Satisfaction Survey

Graduating students of the Health and Human Performance program complete a survey regarding faculty, practical experience, and academic coursework.

Student graduate satisfaction rates:

Students are evaluated on their performance during the practicum/internship by faculty supervisors.
