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Abstract:

Summary of the article presented into a long paragraph about 100-250 words, 5 to 10 lines. Use simple sentences, easy to understand. Attention: should write passive forms, do not abbreviate, do not insert comments and reference citations. The summary content includes the following four ideas: (1) Question and purpose of research, (2) Research methodology, (3) Result. Summarize the main findings of the study, including the figures that may be taken as essential points of the study. (4) Conclusion.

The abstract is independent of the article, it convinces readers to read on or skip the article. Therefore, the author needs to provide information briefly, but with evidence and get straight to the point. Usually the abstract is written after the article is completed..

Keywords: Keywords are separated by commas, in alphabetical order < paragraph Multiple 1.3 pt, before + after space 3 pt>.

1. Introduction

This document is a template of the format for scientific articles posted in the Journal of Applied Science and Technology of Hung Yen University of Technology and Education [1].

The paper should be presented in A4 format vertically, with the following PageSetup parameters: Top: 3.5cm, Bottom: 3.5cm, Left: 3.2cm, Right: 2.8cm, Header: 1.27cm, Footer: 2.8cm. The content of the article uses font size 10; Font: Times New Roman, no stretch or font size;

paragraph: Multiple 1.3 pt, before + after: 3pt; Justified style alignment [2].

Headlines for major sections of the article use lower case sizes, bold, and same font sizes for body text [3].

The content of this section should provide the following information: what is the research problem, has any research work been done to solve the problem, what are the gaps of knowledge that need to be added, thereby indicating the purpose of research. The structure of this part should be arranged as follows:

First of all, the authors provide brief information about the situation and raises the issue that needs research to provide brief information about the circumstances in question. If necessary, use 1-2 sentences summarizing the basic knowledge that are directly related to the research problem. Next, a brief overview of the most recently published related research results, which indicated the gaps of knowledge needed to complete the solution to the research problem. Scientific publications related to the research issue must necessarily be accompanied by citations and references to references. The number of citations should not be too small. Too few citations can be understood that either the matter is of little importance so few people are interested, or the author refuses to find out how the problem has been addressed, what the gaps of scientific knowledge need to add. . Many scientists recommend a minimum number of citations equal to the number of pages in a scientific report. Scientific publications should be cited in prestigious journals. When it is absolutely necessary to use basic knowledge or formulas to use quotations from textbooks. Next, briefly describe how and the results obtained to solve the problem.

At the end of the introduction, the author should introduce the structure of the next sections of the article for readers to follow [4].

2. Materials and/or Methods

Research methodology, research facilities, research content, etc.

If necessary, the content of this part may be divided into several sections. At this time, it is possible to provide information introducing content of small parts. This information is between the title of the main section and the title of the first small section [5].

Format notes and presentation: The headings of small sections (level 2 headings) must be in bold font, size 10, as follows:

2.1. < Sub content title >

If the author needs to split a small section into smaller sections, unify the format of level 3 heading in bold, italic (See illustration below) [6].

2.1.1. Unit of measure and metric

Agree to use SI measurement units for the data in the paper

The unit symbol must be written in lower case and upright, except for liters (L). For example: m, s... Where the unit name is derived from a proper name, the first character in the symbol of the unit must be capitalized. For example: A, K, Pa... When expressing a quantity value in units of measurement, all parts of numerical value and unit of measurement must be recorded. There must be a space between these two components. For example: 22 m (Don't write: 22m or 22 m). When presenting the symbol of temperature units in degrees Celsius, there must be no space between the degree symbol (°) and the symbol Celsius (C). For example: 15 °C (Don't write: 15°C or 15 ° C). When presenting the symbol unit of flat angle is ° (degree); ' (min); " (second), there must be no gaps between the quantities values and the symbol of the unit of measurement. Example: 15°20'30" (Don't write: 15 °20 '30 " hoặc 15 ° 20 ' 30 ") [7].

2.1.2. Equation

The calculation formulas are numbered, enclosed in parentheses on the right margin as illustrated below. Note that the function symbols and variables are in *Italic*; Matrix symbols, vector are in **bold**. For example:

$$f(x) = \int_a^b \sqrt[3]{(5x-9)} dx \quad (1)$$

$$\mathbf{T} = \begin{bmatrix} 1 & 0 & 255 \\ 0 & 1 & 0 \\ 0 & 0 & 1 \end{bmatrix} \quad (2)$$

2.1.3. Figures and tables

Figures and tables are numbered in ascending order for the full text of the article. For example: Figure 1, Figure 2, ... / Table 1, Table 2, Number of drawings and tables must be referenced (introduction, comment) in the text. When arranging pages, the Editor may need to move the position of tables and figures to the top or bottom of the page. Therefore, the author does not use an introduction similar to: "... illustrated in the following figure:", or "Statistics as shown in the following table:". It is necessary to refer to the ordinal numbers of figures, tables, such as "... illustrated in Figure 1", or "Statistics as shown in Table 1".

Try to arrange images and tables close to the text content with reference to images and tables.

If an image consists of many thumbnails, symbolize the thumbnails with the letters a), b),

etc., and explain the contents of the subsections right in the title of the image. Figure 1 illustrates the title format of an image inserted in the article. The format of the components of the tables is illustrated as in Table 1.

Figures in the table must be accurate and clear images. The width of the board and the figure is equal to the width of the column, or of the page vertically. If the drawing (as shown in Figure 2) are too large, it may be presented in a horizontal page (Landscape).

3. Results and discussion

Present the results obtained from the study. The author can use images, tables illustrating the results, and support for discussion. Emphasize new research contributions compared to similar published studies.

4. Conclusion

This section summarizes the important conclusions drawn from the Results and discussion above. Note to avoid duplication with Summary. The author can present research orientations, develop and apply research results.

This section is not required.

The bibliography is cited according to IEEE international standards, and lists only the documents cited in the article. Components of Reference should be presented sufficiently and accurately, convenient for searching. References presented in font size 10, Line spacing: single, before + after: 0pt.

List of References in the order cited in the article. References that have been cited and then re-cited retain the same order numbering as the first time.

Note:

+ Basic format for book:

[No.] Author's name, *Title of book*, edition (if not first). Place of publication: Publisher, Year.

+ Basic format for a chapter of a book:

[No.] Author(s) of chapter, "Title of chapter", In *Title of book*, edition (if not first), Editor(s) of book, Ed. Place of publication: Publisher, Year, Page number(s).

+ Basic format for articles:

[No.] Author(s) of article, "Title of article," *Journal name- italicised*, volume number, issue number, page number(s), year. DOI: xx.xxxxxxxx (if available).

+ Basic format for conference proceedings:

[No.] Author(s) of paper, "Title of paper," *Title of conference's proceeding, palce of organization, time of organization – italicized*, Place of Publication: Publisher, year of publication, page numbers.

+ Basic format for electronic documents (when available online):

[No.] Author(s) of article, "Title of article," *Title of newspaper – italicised* (Year of publication, month day), page number(s).

+ Basic format for documents issued by agencies and organizations:

[No.] Name of the issuing agency, *Name of the document*, Year.

+ Basic format for thesis:

[No.] Author, "*Title of thesis – italicised*," Doctoral dissertation/Master's thesis, Institution, Location, year of preparation of thesis.
