



Subject- TSI Testing for Grades 9-12

Forney High School Students,

We will be offering the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) at Forney High School once a month, on Saturdays throughout the school year. Forney ISD will be offering this test free of charge to all CURRENT 9th- 12th grade students. Want to learn more before signing up? Check out the info below.

What is the Texas Success Initiative Assessment or TSIA 2.0?

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) is a series of placement tests for students enrolling in public colleges and universities in Texas. The tests help Texas schools determine whether you're ready for college-level courses in the areas of reading, writing, and math.

If you're not ready for college-level courses, the tests help determine what types of courses or intervention will best prepare you for college-level work.

Who needs to take the TSI?

Generally, colleges require students to take the TSI prior to entry to determine college readiness in English and Math.

Seniors that are planning on attending college next year and haven't taken the TSI should sign up. For students in grades 9-11, there are two reasons to consider taking the TSI.

- 1) The student plans on taking dual credit classes next school year. Passing TSI scores are required for students to take dual credit classes. 9th grade students in Collegiate Academy will also need passing TSI scores to continue in the program and should consider signing up.
- 2) TSI passing scores are one way students can meet College, Career & Military Readiness Standards. It is the expectation of FISD that each student meets this standard.

How do I register for the TSI?

Step 1: Complete Pre-Assessment activity and save certificate

In order to register and take the TSI, students are required to complete a mandatory pre-assessment activity. Once completed, the student will receive a certificate. This certificate will need to be saved by the student for current and future use. It will be required to be uploaded on the registration form for each requested test session. (Students will not have to retake the assessment if they are planning to retake the TSI, however, they will need to upload the original

certificate each time they register.) Students will need to create an account and then select the Texas Success Initiative 2.0 Pre-Assessment Activity (TSIA2-PAA) practice test.

Step 2: Register for the test

If you are interested in taking the TSI, please sign up using the links in the chart below for the test date that works best for you. Be sure to save and upload your pre-assessment certificate.

Students may be limited to two attempts in a school year. Seats are limited. Please make arrangements and set reminders for test day. Students who receive a confirmed seat and then do not show up to the test may be not allowed to register for future test dates.

Closer to the testing date, information will be shared directly with students who sign up to test. Again, students must have completed the pre-assessment and provide documentation before taking part in testing. In addition, students must present a **photo ID** (school ID with photo, drivers license) to enter the testing session.
