Creator Deity: Creator deities are those that came before the gods, and were, and are, directly involved in the creation of the world, and some Gods. Their bodies directly make up parts of the world, like the sky, the water, and the earth.

Enterra: The world from which Kay hails. Very similar to earth, but with distinct differences. Magic flows through all living creatures there, and all can channel it, though in different amounts. The Gods take an active part in shaping the world as it is known, and with their warring, many of the mortal creatures that inhabit it take their sides to worship different gods.

Domain: A part of the world which has been split up by the various gods. Ex. Sky, Sea, Surface, Cave

Prime: The strongest God in a domain. While some gain the title of Prime through feats of mental fortitude or trickery, most gain this title from physically beating out the previous prime.

Enterra's Creation Story

When the world of Enterra was still yet to come into being, it is said the divine creator deities roamed the cosmos aimlessly, creating as was their nature, and filling the star system with all types of things. It was the creator deity of the earth, Gyun (Goo - you - n) and the creator deity of fire, Leverin (Leaver - in) that were the first to create together, and together they worked to create the burning sun. It was the creator deity of water, Ondtho (On - d - th - oh) that came next, and together with the other two they created a planet from their own bodies that was meant for life to exist on. All of life came next, given shape and strength from Gyun, blood to run through their bodies from Ondtho, and finally the spark of life from Leverin.

These first beings were small in form, unable to grow nor live long. It was then that the youngest and smallest of the creator deities, the air creator deity Vhrwen (V - err - when) came that air was first brought to Enterra, and from there, life began to flourish.

In all life flowed a bit of the creator deities ability to create, being their direct creations, and through some it is stronger. This is what is called magic in Enterra.

Newly formed gods, still young and inexperienced, attempted to harness this power to take power for themselves and lead. This led to much warring that continues even to this day. Gods created other gods to fight their battles with them, and through that many other gods were created, some even stronger than the ones that created them. Eventually it was decided to split

up the domains. From these domains, a Prime would rise to power, taking lead. Occasionally domains go to war against other domains for more land, but thankfully this is uncommon.

Kaydron's Lore

"Kaydron, the god of storms is said to have been created directly from two creator deities. Although this is a very rare occurrence, it would explain his strength. It is said that when Vhrwen and Ondtho first came into contact during the creation of Enterra an egg was formed from their very essence. When this egg eventually hatched, from it was born Kaydron, first of the dragons, and Prime of the Sky domain. It is said that the creatures of both sea and sky raised him, teaching him their strength and swiftness. By the time he had fully taken form, humans had begun to take proper shape, and Kaydron decided to live alongside us for a while, taking our shape, learning our culture and protecting us from harm, both from other gods, and creatures alike. It was because of these deeds that we humans came to know his strength, and began to worship him.

It is said, the Prime at the time, Dynarinn (Dinner -in) personally came to challenge Kaydron when he found that the young god was growing in power from the reverence the humans were giving him. Through a hard fought battle, Kaydron managed to defeat Dynarinn, though this was a sad day. In taking up the mantle of Prime, he could no longer live amongst the humans. With a heavy heart he rose to the sky domain to take his place as Prime, and it is said he resides there to this day. Many say that he still protects humans from the sky, and each strike of lightning during a storm is him banishing monsters from the world."

Although the previous Prime of the sky domain rarely wared with the gods or Primes of other domains, this can not be said of gods of his own domain. Though Kaydron himself rarely creates other gods, many still vied for his position of Prime. None of them he took particular offense to, until the enigmatic god of the sun itself, Falmitar challenged him.

Falmitar (Fall - mitt - are) has challenged Kaydron at almost any chance he is able to, and due to where he draws his godhood, he is incredibly powerful, and sadly, it was during one of his many sneaky tricks against Kaydron that he managed to dethrone the god.

It was not the attempts, and taking of his throne that made him so hated to the storm god, rather it is his underhanded tactics that he uses to attempt to win. Anything goes for the sun prime, even once killing Kaydron's friends, the moon goddess Atlena (At- Len- Ah) by destroying the moon, an act of which has left Enterra without a moon even to this day. It was in doing this act that Kaydron decided he would never let the detestable Falmitar keep the title of Prime of the sky domain

Although he is quite powerful simply by his own strength, Gods in Enterra gain much strength from their followers, thus the defeated Kaydron set out across the realms and galaxies to grow his following. It was in coming to earth that Kaydron learned of what the humans there called twitch, and through it, he decided this was how he would grow his following there on earth.
