have access to technology and need to establish norms early that build into secondary

- -Clear with parents about expectations also
- -Integrate as much as possible into what we do
- -PBIS technology guidelines produced by Jen Johnson last year as Tech TOSA
- -At JM, more clarity on the lessons that are coming for SEL lessons; need to know what is coming up so can preview and prepare
- -Elementary has a plan in advance
- -Counselor preview links for appropriateness; maybe themes to follow throughout the school (i.e. SEL lesson, assembly, projects on campus, events)
- -Calendar
- -Kids do not get a lot of access in lower grades without lab
