Call to Order

Review Meeting minutes from August - approved

### **Old Business**

- 1.) Fundraising Raffle - updates from Bev/Erin
  - a.) Bev talked to someone on the Trap Team about raffling off prizes - they worked through Ahlman's Gun Shop for the prize
    - i.) You need a gambling license through the state
    - ii.) You would pay for the cost of printing the tickets
    - iii.) Each archer would have to sell 20-30 tickets and they sell for about \$20 each
  - b.) Erin talked to someone about Ducks Unlimited about a fundraising raffle and they have a program
    - i.) You pay for the prize package and they print 500 tickets for you
      - (1) the tickets are usually sell for about \$10-20 per ticket
    - ii.) They help with the gambling licensing
    - iii.) Need to have everything 12 weeks in advance
    - iv.) You can buy more tickets for an extra cost
  - c.) We all really liked the Ducks Unlimited option as a possible fundraiser for Nationals. We are tabling the issue until next season when we are doing a Nationals Team
  - d.) We talked about getting a Yeti cooler or something smaller to raffle off for this year instead of doing suckers

  - c.) Let's go with just milk and no orange juice since the orange juice was so expensive
  - d.) Jamee - looking into coffee so that we could make coffee to sell but also sell bags of coffee as a fundraiser

  - a.) Abbey showed us the new banners - they look great
  - b.) Abbey will get the tiers of current sponsors to Jess for the website
- 4.) Nationals Hotel Reservations - update from Abbey

- a.) The hotel would make us cover the rooms that were not booked so Abbey did not block anything
  - b.) Kentucky is tricky because NASP books hotel groups for the event
