Instructions for EISA Skiers who do not have a NENSA Licence:

Please note that the SkiReg.com registration sites (UVM 2/3 and Dartmouth 2/10) have been updated to include an option for "NENSA 1-Day Membership" for "EISA Open" skiers. All other Eastern Cup registration pages only offer this option for "Visiting Foreign Skiers." NENSA will monitor the 1-Day entries for these two combined events by validating against your current rosters as listed on Bart EISA Carnival Entries.

Open EISA skiers without NENSA memberships should answer "Yes" to the first question and click "I do NOT have and annual NENSA membership #" to the second question – \$10.00 will be added to their entry.

If skiers have an active NENSA membership they should answer "No" to the first question and click "I have an annual NENSA membership #" to the second question (or

leave it blank) – no additional fees will be applied and junior athletes will be scored to JN rankings.
