

Show N' Tell

Objective: SWBAT present a one minute speech on their “show n’ tell” object.

Assignment Specs: Students will be responsible with presenting a one minute presentation on an object that is important to them in their life. In addition to presenting a speech on the object, the student will also be responsible with preparing the speech in a written format. Written below are the necessary elements that must be included in the students show n’ tell presentation.

- Show n’ Tell Object
 - The object that is brought into school and presented on should be an object that has an importance significance to you. It should be something that you cherish or believe is really “cool.”
- The Written Speech
 - Students will be responsible with writing down a written speech on their object that they are bringing into school. The written speech should include the following elements:
 - A brief description of the object that is brought into school
 - Tells the audience about the origin of the object
 - Tells the audience why it is an important object to you. Why do you cherish it? Or why do you think it is “cool.”
- The Oral Speech
 - The oral speech should include the following elements:
 - Eye contact with audience (students will be allowed to read of written speech script)
 - Audible volume of voice
 - Proper gestures and facial expressions
 - Obvious preparation
