Pray First!

- An accountability partner to help hold us accountable in our struggles and sin can be very helpful in our walk with the Lord. Who might you consider asking to be an accountability partner? You don't need to share this if you don't want to, but think about it and prayerfully consider asking someone to do that for you!

Run the Race with endurance!

- Are you living with intentionality to share Jesus with others?
- Running suggests that time is limited and it's urgent. Do you believe that? What are you doing about it?
- What are you doing daily to build spiritual muscle so that you can have endurance through the valleys? Daily time in God's WORD is an essential part of building strong spiritual muscle!
