Digital Notetaking and Source Log

[How to Guide](#) for using this digital notetaking and source log page.

Notes should be:

- **Brief** –to remind you, not a section by section account
- **Clear** –you need to be able to quickly skim them for specific points later
- **Easy to understand**
- **Organized** in a way that you understand
- **Relevant** –only make notes on the main points from which you can draw conclusions; do not write out all the details
