BARBARA LOTZE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FUTURE TEACHERS

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for the Barbara Lotze Scholarship for Future Teachers. Applicants must declare their intent to prepare for, and engage in, a career in physics teaching at the high school level and must, at the time the scholarship funds are received by the student, be: An undergraduate student enrolled in an accredited two-year college, four-year college or a university; or a high school senior accepted for such enrollment; Pursuing, or planning to pursue, a course of study leading toward a career in physics teaching in the high schools. Successful applicants receive a stipend of up to \$2,000 and a complimentary AAPT Student Membership for one year. The scholarship may be granted to an individual for each of four years.
