

Privacy Policy for Obstacle Rush Racers

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and protect user information when you use the mobile game "Obstacle Rush Racers" (the "Game"). By accessing or using the Game, you agree to the practices described herein.

1. Information We Collect

We only collect information necessary to provide and improve the Game experience, which includes:

Non-personal information: Game progress (e.g., level completion, scores), device information (e.g., operating system version, device model), and gameplay data (e.g., in-game actions, performance metrics). This data is collected automatically when you use the Game.

Optional personal information: If you choose to use features like cloud save or leaderboards (integrated via Google Play Services), we may access your Google account ID (only to link your gameplay data to your account, without accessing other account details like email or name).

2. How We Use Collected Information

The information we collect is used solely for the following purposes:

Maintain and improve the Game's functionality (e.g., fix bugs, optimize performance).

Provide personalized features (e.g., track game progress, display leaderboards).

Analyze user behavior to enhance gameplay experience (e.g., identify popular game modes).

3. Data Storage and Protection

We store collected data on secure servers and implement industry-standard security measures (e.g., encryption) to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, or modification of user data.

Non-personal gameplay data is retained for as long as needed to support Game operations; if you delete your Google account or uninstall the Game, linked progress data may be removed.

4. Third-Party Services

The Game may integrate third-party services (e.g., Google Play Services for leaderboards/cloud saves). These third parties have their own privacy policies, and we are not responsible for their data practices. We recommend reviewing the privacy policies of these services before using related features.

5. User Rights

You have the right to:

Access the non-personal gameplay data we collect about you.

Request the deletion of your linked game progress data (where applicable).

Opt out of non-essential data collection by disabling related features (e.g., leaderboards) in the Game settings.
