

9th Grade Career Readiness

Log into Naviance:

1. Go to your portal: <https://launchpad.classlink.com/haverfordsd>
2. Click Sign in with Google
3. Choose your Haverford email
4. Click on the Naviance icon in your portal

For students who have not completed Naviance Future Planning Presentation and Quiz:

1. View the Presentation on the HHS Counseling website under PA Career Readiness Plan - 9th grade tab.
2. From the home page of Naviance, click on the *Planner* tab at the top.
3. Click on **Tasks**.
4. Scroll down to *Tasks you need to work on*.
5. Locate and click on the TASK - **9th Grade Naviance Presentation and Quiz**.
6. Click the link to **take this survey** located next to the red diamond with the arrow in it. (It may help to have the presentation open in another window while you are completing the quiz.)

For students who have not completed Achieveworks Skills and/or Reflection:

1. Once you log in, you should click on the *Self-Discovery* tab at the top.
2. Then right-click on the assessment called: **Skills**. Choose *Open link in new window*.
3. Click the button to start the assessment. If you have already completed the assessment, you can review your results.
4. Once you have completed the assessment and reviewed your results **please leave this window open**.
5. Click back on the other Naviance window/tab that you have open. (It should be the home page of Naviance.)
6. Click on the *Planner* tab at the top.
7. Click on **Tasks**.
8. Scroll down to *Tasks you need to work on*.
9. Locate and click on the TASK - **9th Grade Complete Achieveworks Skills Reflection**.
10. Click the link to **take this survey** located next to the red diamond with the arrow in it.
11. Please complete the reflection using the information from your Achieveworks Skills Assessment results that are still open in the other window.
