WIAA Pre-Event Emergency Action Plan (EAP) Meeting Information

Present: Home/Away Coaches, *Officials, *Athletic Director, *Athletic Trainers, *EMS, *Team Physicians, *Event Manager (*if present and available)

1. Is there an Athletic Trainer (AT) on site? If not, who is the lead responder for an emergency?
 - a. A trainer is present for all track meets
2. Where is the closest AED and who will retrieve it?
 - a. The Trainer keeps an AED on her person and in the Men's Bathroom
3. Is there other emergency equipment available? (spine board, first aid kit, splints)
 - a. First Aid kits are available at the Concessions Stand and with the Trainer
4. Are there environmental concerns? (Heat Index, lightning)
 - a. Forecast: (Check Daily Forecast and Discuss and potential Issues)
5. Emergency Communication? (Radio, Hand Signals, Cell)
 - a. At track meets we use cell phones. Admin, Police, Supervisors, Athletic Trainer, Ticket Gates, Concessions, Announcer all have communicated contact info. The Announcer, Clerk of Course, and Timing company will have radios.
6. Who will call 911 and meet arriving EMS? (location and access)
 - a. Whoever calls 911 should then contact someone with a radio to coordinate arrival of EMS, Enter field at gate N1 (near tracks) or W9 (south entrance)
7. Is there an EAP on site?
 - a. When there is a Trainer on site and/or Announcer we have EAP plans with them. The event manager has knowledge of the EAP. This document will be the guiding outline for the EAP.
