- Vendors We have 4 so far please share with businesses -
  - Vendor fee is \$70 per table for sale vendors, \$50 for information only tables, \$25 for non profits
    - If vendors donate a basket they get a \$30 discount off of their table fee.
- Next meeting for Kick Off event 07/18 at 7:00
  - going over volunteers who's going to head up what I AM NOT DOING IT ALL at the event - too many times it comes down to 1 person - and we will be rotating - so one person isn't doing the fun job all the time and another person is not - this way everyone is happy
- Lastly meeting with teams I know team meetings are happening soon Laura would like to attend the team meetings for as many teams as possible to talk about fundraising - the more parents that know in person about this event the greater the turnout the more money QMFA makes

#### **Old Business:**

  - Need to target younger teams for retention
  - Determine where holes need to be filled
- Snack Stand Sign Ups
  - Board Members will need to open/close
  - o Parents/Volunteers will cook and work windows
    - What format will be most practical?
      - Sign up genius will be used for kitchen duty during games
    - Discussion regarding if teams should need to require both window and cooking during practices
      - For August assign two teams per week to cover front and back
        - o Would need an on call board member
        - Alexis has volunteered to cook two days a week
      - For game days football teams assigned for front of the house and board members will need to cover the back
    - Coaches are responsible to hold parents accountable for volunteer time
- Golf outing
  - There were 80 golfers
  - Laura reported that Money \$11,724 was received and \$6,681 was spent
    - This is unofficial and needs to be confirmed with Steph to match deposits.
  - Going forward square fees need to be applied to the golfers and not QMFA.
