- We are rebuilding our Tier II program effectiveness this year and are working with an outside consultant.
- We have added options (such as CICO, HOPS, and a Wellness-based Art group to address social/emotional concerns).
- Each program has students set a goal on the first day and then reflect on the last day. Staff who are involved conduct follow up Google forms to give us feedback.
- Tier II/III, **students are selected for something specific like grades, discipline, absenteeism, or Wellness needs.** They meet with a team member, are assigned a Tier II intervention, then progress monitored. If this process doesn't work, then they are moved forward to Tier III.

- 40 students actively involved
- Students organized themselves into three subcommittees:
  - Gender/Sports Equity; Reducing Student Stress (Testing Calendar); Campus Climate (Humanizing our Campus by reducing the use of dehumanizing language on campus)
- We are creating core messaging for each subcommittee. The Campus Climate Group gave survey that 1,100 students took. Team of teachers, students, and administrators made improving our campus climate the primary objective of our tier 1 work for the remainder of the school year. This effort aligns with district MTSS Tier 1 plan. PD/MTSS Coordinators are tasked yearly with obtaining data about a tier 1 phenomenon and use it to effect change throughout campus. The

survey the ASEC students created has been the catalyst for the tier 1 action items we intend to implement this coming semester. We will be meet early January to plan for our January 30th PD Day. On the 30th the PD/MTSS team will engage the faculty and staff in this work. The data from the ASEC survey is driving our work. The fact that students created the survey (adults vetted) makes it super relevant.
