Program Vision/Description

The San Pasqual Union Dance Team (SPUDT) is a parent-volunteer-led program aimed at providing students with lifelong physical activity, recreation, and social skills. The program also aims to promote sportsmanship, inclusivity, discipline, and comradery among the students of San Pasqual Union (SPU). The SPUDT is open to all students of SPU in 1st – 8th Grade.

This program promotes an opportunity for students at SPU to experience the many physical, mental, and social benefits of dancing through an extracurricular dance program. It encompasses one or more of the following: Instruction in mixed genres of dance (e.g., hip hop, jazz, modern, Latin ballroom), School performance at school events, possible after school “field trip” opportunities.

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All members of the dance team are expected to follow the [SPU Athletic Code of Conduct](#).

Attendance - A student is expected to attend all classes on his/her schedule on the day of an event. Habitual absences may result in suspension from the team. To be eligible to participate in the event of the day, the athlete must be present for the entirety of the day, unless the student has been excused from school attendance for such reasons as doctor's appointment, field trip, funerals, etc.

Expenses

There is no participation fee required. However, parents are asked to contribute in one or more of the following ways:

- Provide snacks and beverages for practices
- Serve as chaperones as needed
- Provide transportation in the event of a "field trip"

Requirements

No special equipment or clothing is needed to participate. Students should wear clothing that they can easily move in. Close-toed shoes are preferred.

Uniforms- The student-athlete may be loaned a uniform(t-shirt) to be worn during the season and then returned. Uniforms should be treated with care. Athletes and their parents/guardians will be responsible to replace any uniform that is lost, damaged, or not returned.

District

- Gathers sponsors, donors, and collaborators, as needed
