

1. Filter > pixelate> Mezzotint
 - a. Type= medium lines
2. Filter > Blur > Radial Blur
 - a. Amount =100
 - b. Method = zoom
 - c. Quality = best
3. Repeat this radial blur 4-5 times.
 - a. You can easily repeat the radial blur by hitting command F, do this 4-5 times
4. Duplicate the background Layer
 - a. Command j
5. Make sure the top layer is active (the new duplicated background)
6. Filter > Distort > Twirl
 - a. Set to a +degrees (this is where you can get creative) I like to use anywhere from 50-80 degrees
7. Click on the background layer to make it active
8. Filter > Distort > Twirl
 - a. Set to a - degrees (negative number)
 - b. You have to use the exact opposite number that you used in step 6a, except make it negative.
 - i. So if you used 50 in step 6a, you will use -50 now.
9. Make the top layer active
10. Set the layer to this blend mode:
 - a. Choose a **Blend Mode** such as screen, overlay, lighten, soft light
11. Go to the fly out menu in the layers panel, select flatten
12. Finished!!!
