 - Let's have a street party! Especially on a cul de sac is nice
 - It'd be convenient to coordinate it with National Night Out which is the first saturday in August.
 - Let's wait to announce it pretty late, depending on pandemic status and how comfortable we feel with having such a gathering.
 - Last November, we talked about the Map-Your-Neighborhood project[1], which helps us to know our neighbors and help one another in case of emergencies. Let's do this!
