Classroom Connections

Things you can do at home to help your child.

- Read every night. Have your child write about their favorite character. Have your child tell you traits about this
 character.
- Discuss your family's culture and traditions. Share photographs and meaningful artifacts with your child.
- Make a list of opinions your child might have about things, people or current events to write about. Pick an opinion to write about and give supporting reasons about it.
- Skip count forward and backward by 2 (evens and odds), 5, and 10
