Reports:

New Business:

CDEs - We did our practice day but we should continue practicing. The actual contest date is the 24th. You need to be in the ag room by 6:15. Hopefully we'll be back by 3:15. Livestock and meats kids wear warm clothes. Lunch is provided by the chapter. You should bring money for snacks because there's a vending machine. There's a chance to stop at Culver's. Wear your FFA t-shirts and bring all the stuff that you need. We bought the floriculture kits today.

Banquet - It's March 15th. The theme is birthday. Wear official dress or something nice. We have a lot of jackets so you can borrow one. You just need a white shirt, black pants, and black shoes. You need to RSVP so we know about food.

Pig Tag Pick Up - You need to pick up your tags if you're planning on selling at the fair. It's April 13th at the community center.

Feed a Farmer - Ryan and Jack are grilling up some hotdogs and fry up some baked potatoes. It's originally set for March 19th. Jack wanted to move it later in the year when farmers are actually doing something. The problem with that is that they most likely won't be home and you couldn't find them as easily.

Officer Apps - Apps are due March 19th. If you need help, any past officer can help. Ask Nancy, she'd be glad to help. High school members only. It does take work and you can't slack on that work. All you have to do is fill out the applications online.

Ag Olympics - March 17th at the Middle School. Anyone who is signed up for planning needs to help plan. We need help to run the actual Olympics. The plan needs to be done by Monday and shown to Mr. Robinson. They're like the actual Olympics but with a farm background twist. Middle schoolers can help plan but get more people to participate on the actual date.

State Talent - For state talent you can dance. It's due April 22nd. Nancy will help you fill out the application. You could dance, sing, or comedy.

Livestock - Anyone who is showing an animal to sell, Allied isn't going to buy any animals this year. Last year they had many big requests. They can't financially afford to buy anything. Instead, they're doing a program. Each eligible participant can go to the website, fill out the form, they get a free shirt and feed bucket. You have to be an active Allied member and must be showing an animal and the fair or state fair. You could earn money after the fair.

NCA - National Chapter Award. Last year we filled it out and we made it to Nationals. Let's hope for that again. We can use the same events but change the writing. We need to start out right now to be able to accomplish a lot. It's due to Ms. G by March 20.

Strawberries - They're supposed to come on March 12th at 11 o'clock. You need to tell your customers to come and pick them up at 1 or later. We need to have some kids run pickup. All money needs to be turned in for them to go out the door.

Mission - Bring money for food. You'll leave the school at 3:45 on Friday and be back at 4:30 on Saturday. You need to write thank you to the Alumni because they paid for the room. You need to wear official dress.
